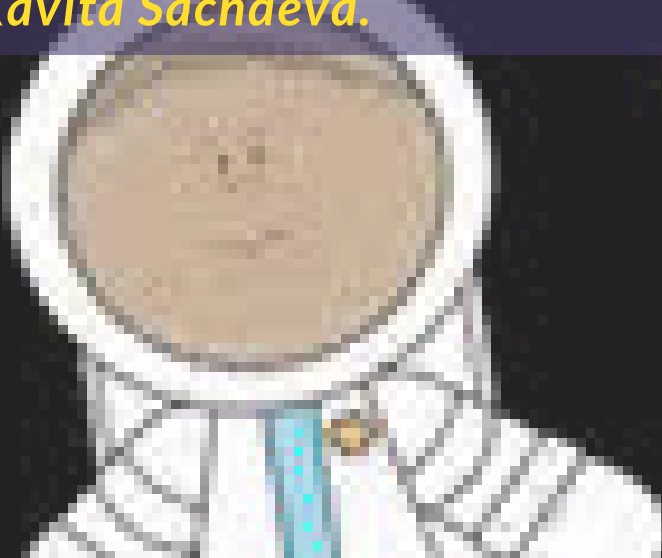




# Human Rights Day

# ASSEMBLY PLANTATION DRIVE

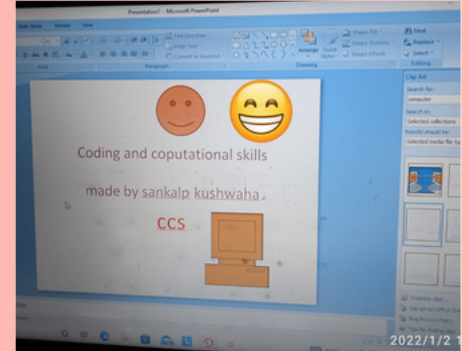
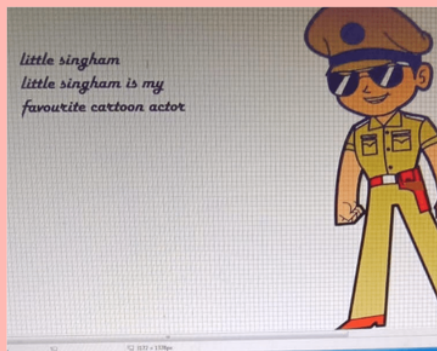

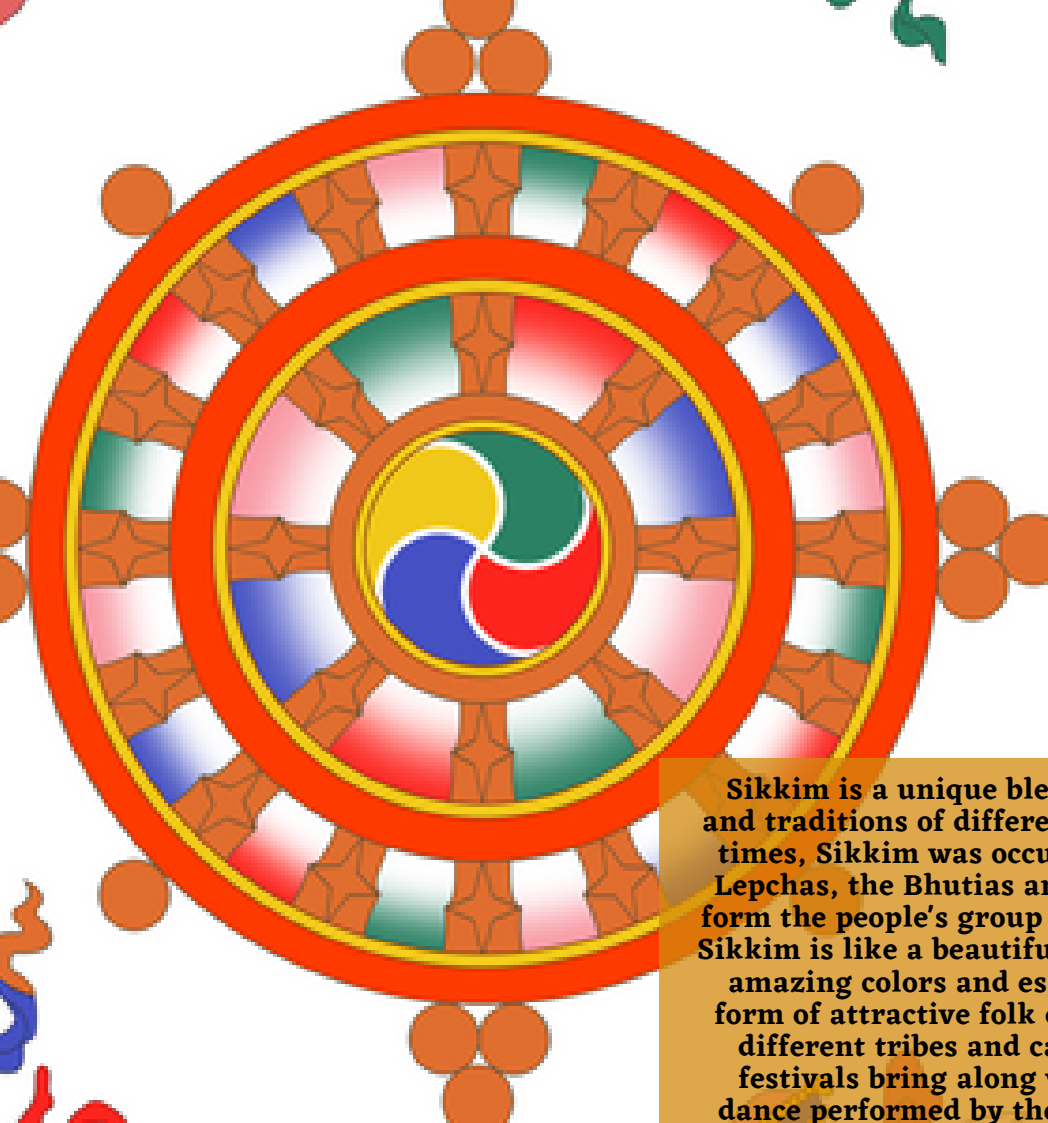
# WORLD COMPUTER LITERACY DAY

**World Computer Literacy Day is celebrated in order to provide proper awareness related to computer literacy for people around the world.**

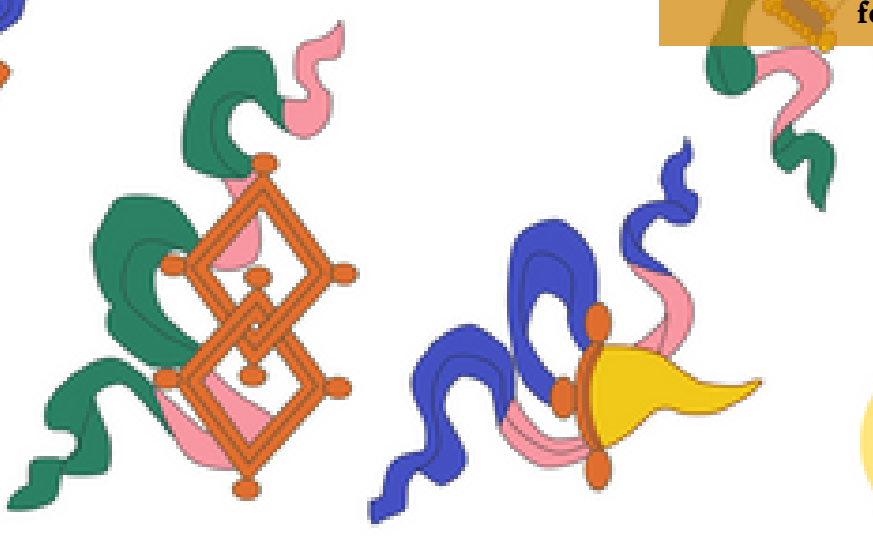
**Computer literacy is the knowledge and ability to use computers and technology efficiently. Computer literacy is considered a very important skill.**





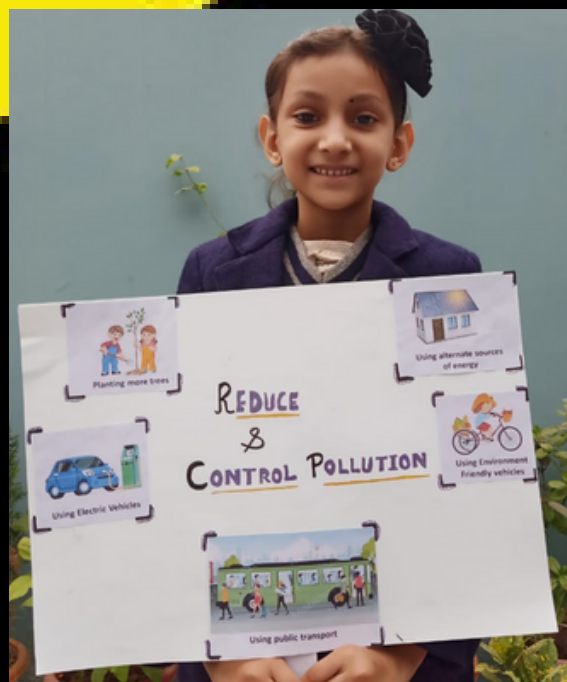

National Pollution Prevention Day is observed annually on December 2 in memory of the people who lost their lives in 1984 gas tragedy.

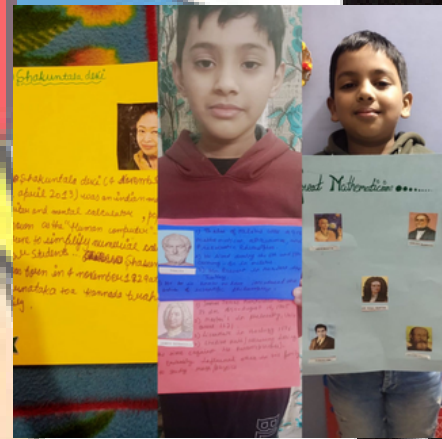
Students of class 3rd participated enthusiastically by raising slogans,holding placards and conveying the various aspects of pollution along with preventive activities.

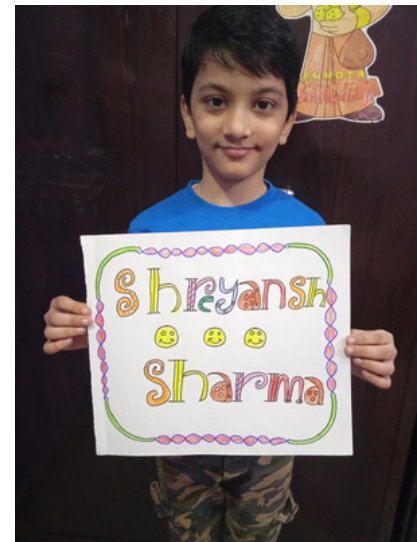


# Happy Children's Day

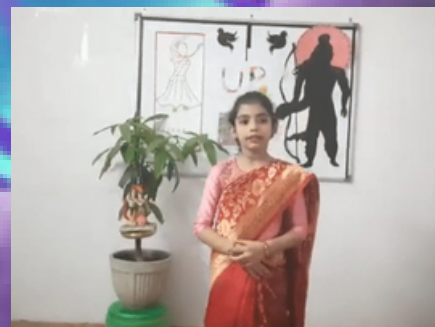




# ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMS

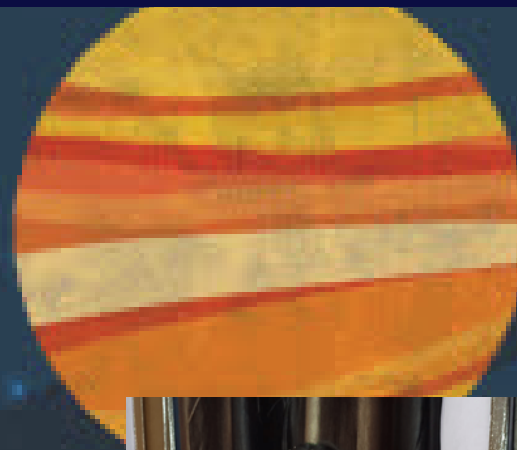
# PAINT WITH MATHS

The main purpose behind this activity was to maximise students knowledge and understanding about importance and concept of division properly.



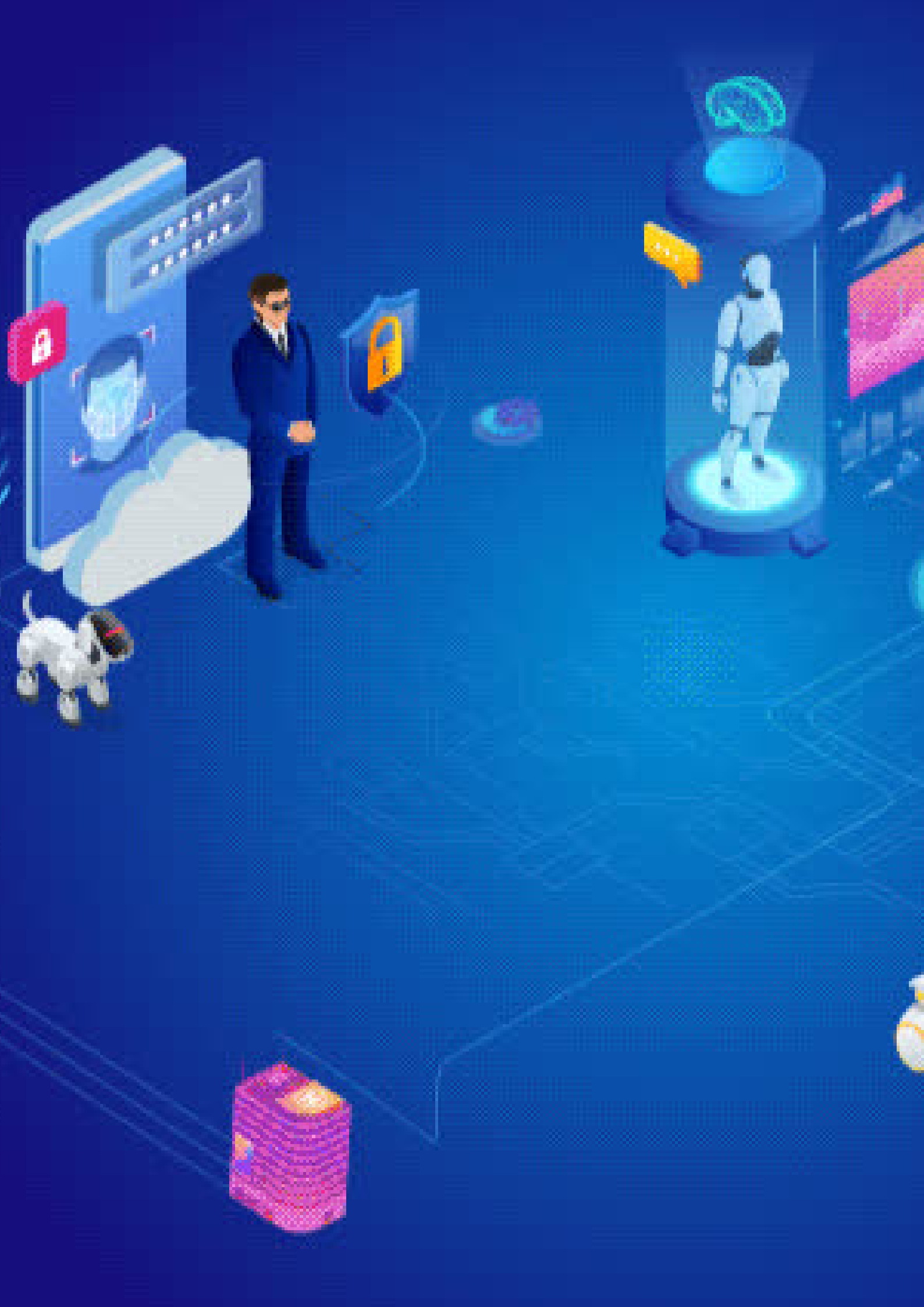
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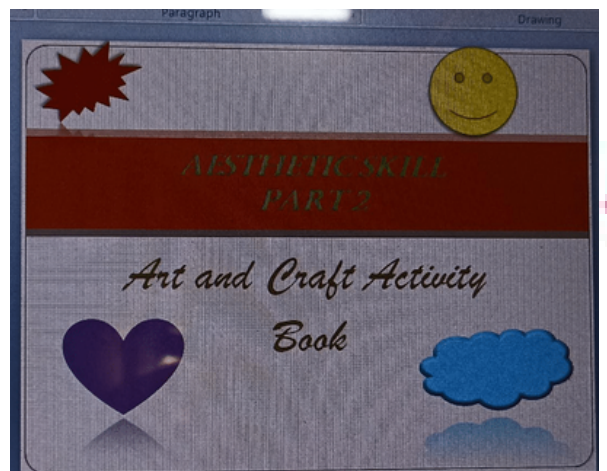
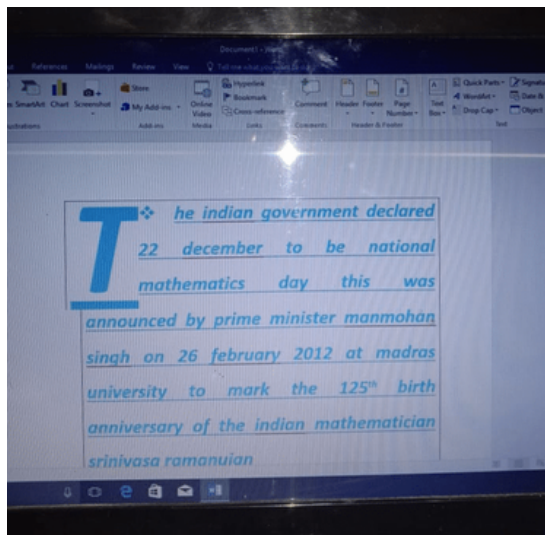
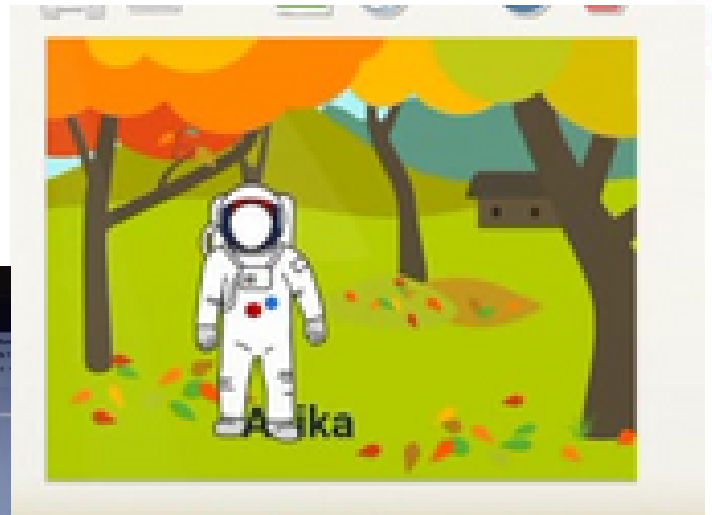
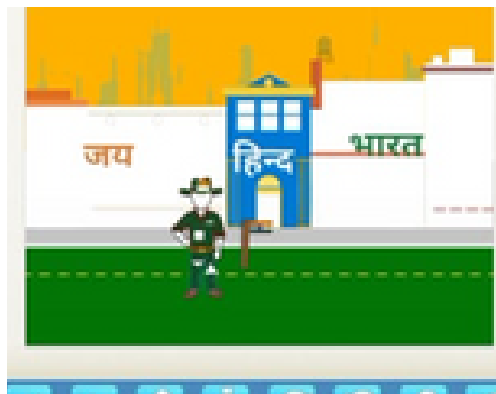
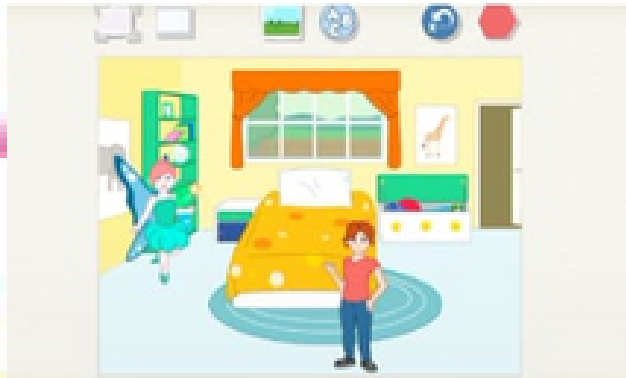
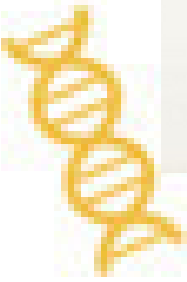
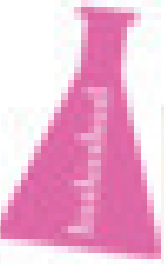
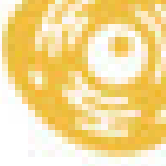
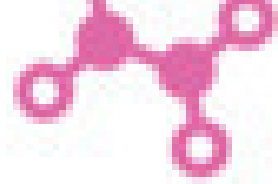
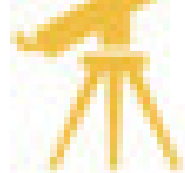
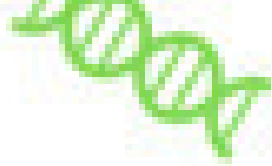
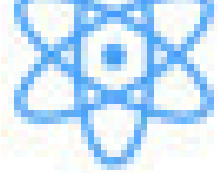




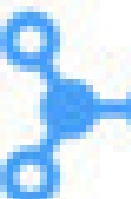
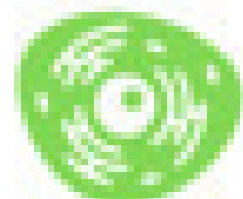
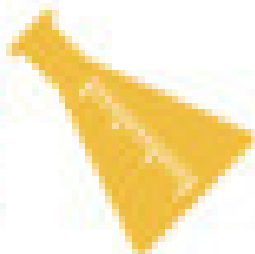
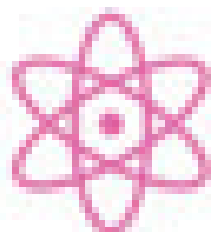
