Dear reader Greetings to you..








Pink Colour Day











Halloween Day Activity


Thanksgiving Day is celebrated in the fourth week of the November.






Guru Nanak Jayanti






Activity On Clay Dough




International Girl Phild Day






Dussehra craft


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Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day)


Theme- The World We Make – Inspires Kindness.

Let's join and encourage others to help report acts of kindness.



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


Multidisciplinary Bagless-Happy Days Activity

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
VIRTUAL TOUR TO MAHARASHTRA


New Post On the World Post Day students acknowledged the Postal service by writing and posting letters to their families and friends.

the best of all, love.








Navratri Celebration Date - 14/10/2021


Teachers discussed about the importance of this festival. They conveyed to the students that Eid is a time to share happiness.

No Bag Day (Day & Night Activity) class 2


Date - 15/11/2021

As a part of 'Happiness Curriculum' the topic 'Our Universe' was discussed with the students.



Students were able to identity cardinal directions on a map, different planets and explain the role of gravity in solar system. It was fascinating and exciting for the


students as it also developed their critical thinking, creativity, and motor skills.


