Greetings to you..

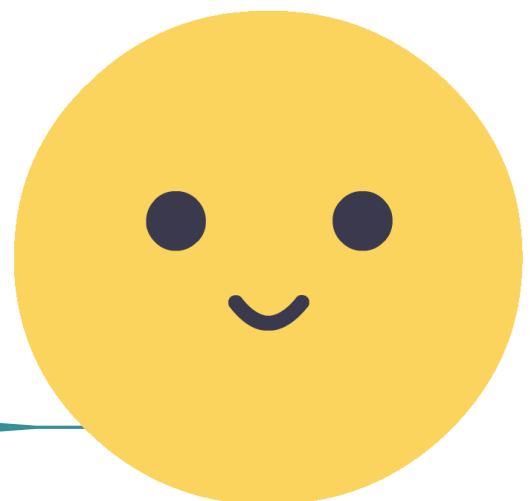

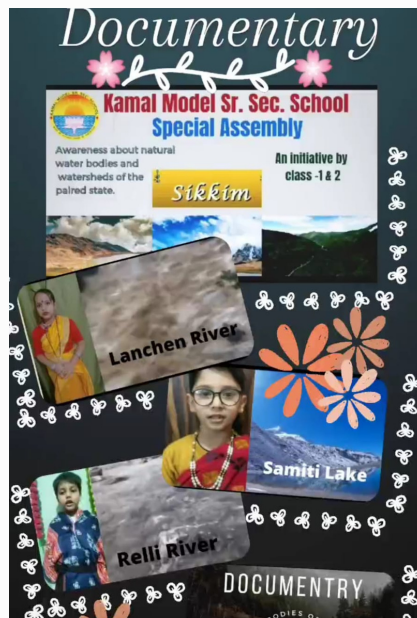
# Sikkim Assembly 1st-2nd class

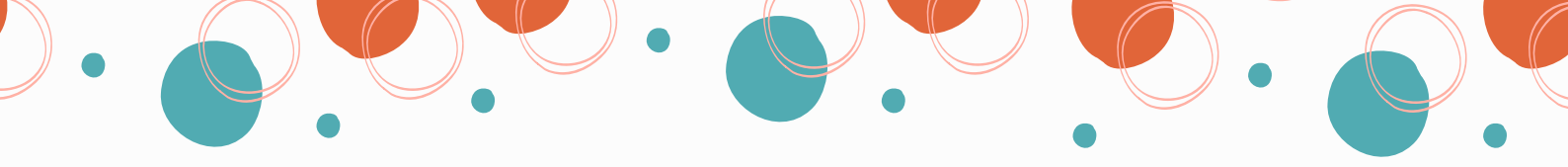




# Shining Rockstars

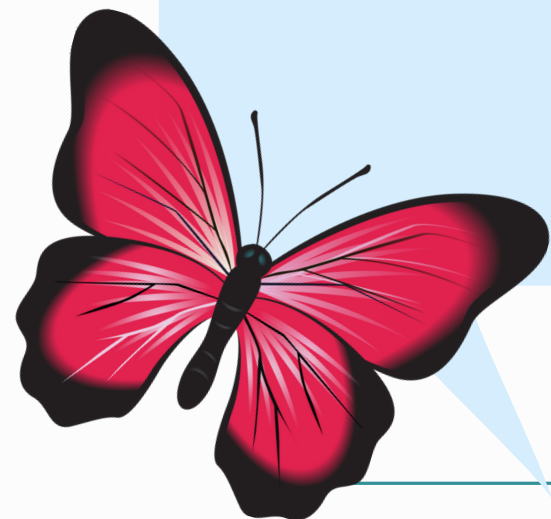

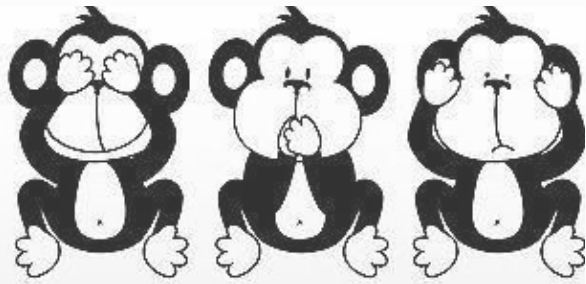
# Gandhi Jayanti

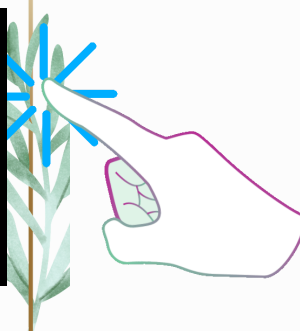
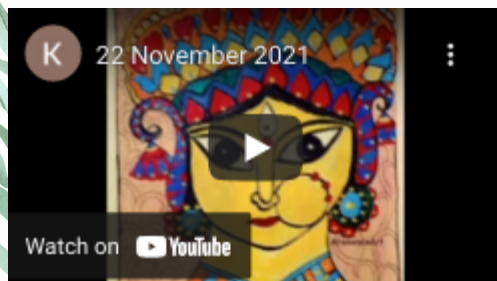






# Durga Puja

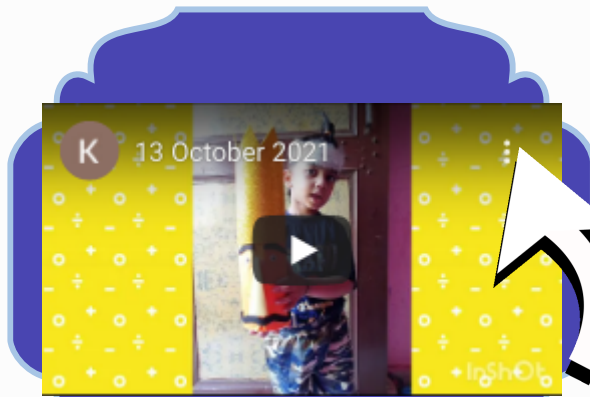

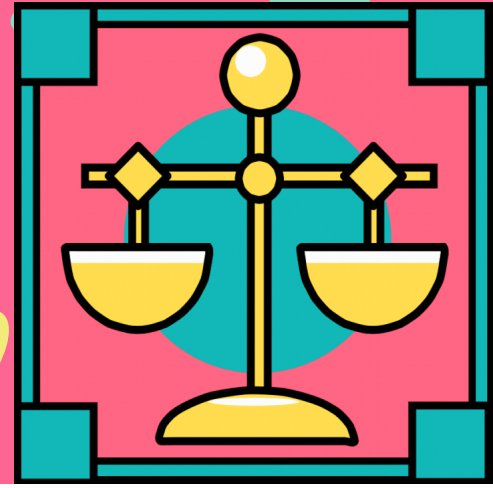
# CONCEPT OF oval shape

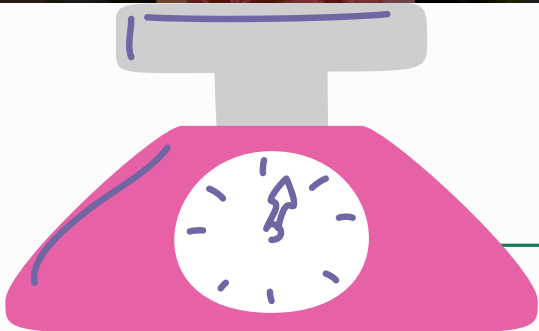
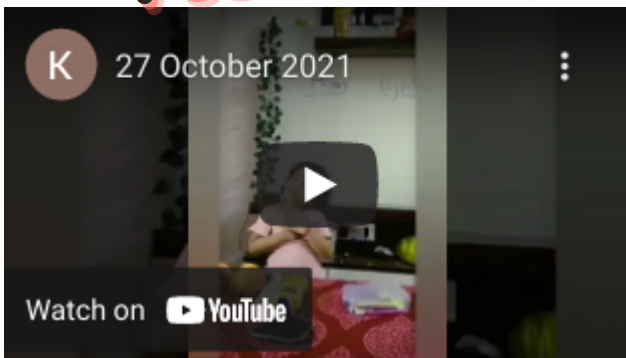
# Heavy and Light Activity

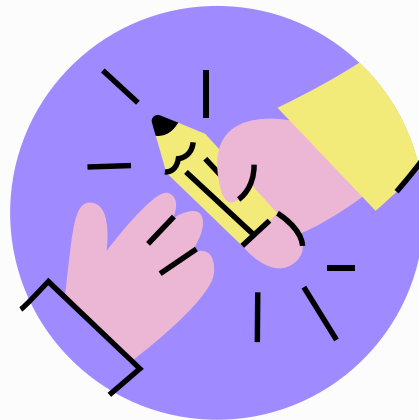

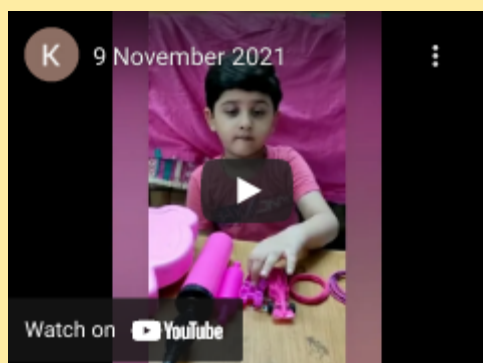

**Pink Colour Day was celebrated to make the little kids aware about colours and how they add beauty to things around us.**

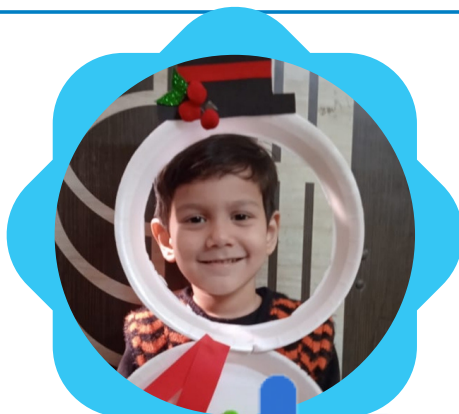

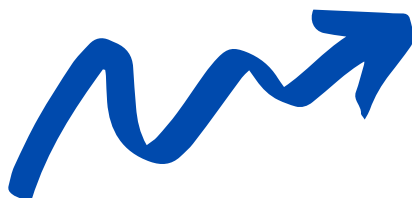


# Fun with Clay

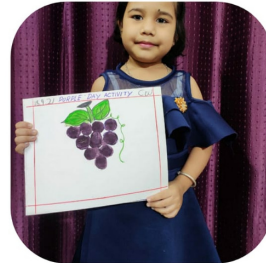


# Purple Day Activity

Purple Day celebrations prompted the young ones to think how colour enhances and influences our lives. It turned out to be a remarkable day filled with fun and enthusiasm.



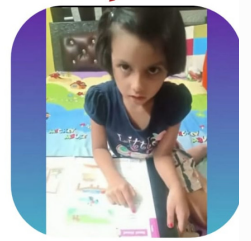
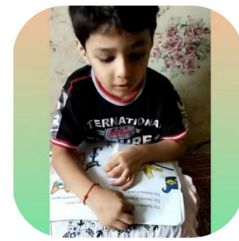


# National Read a Book Day

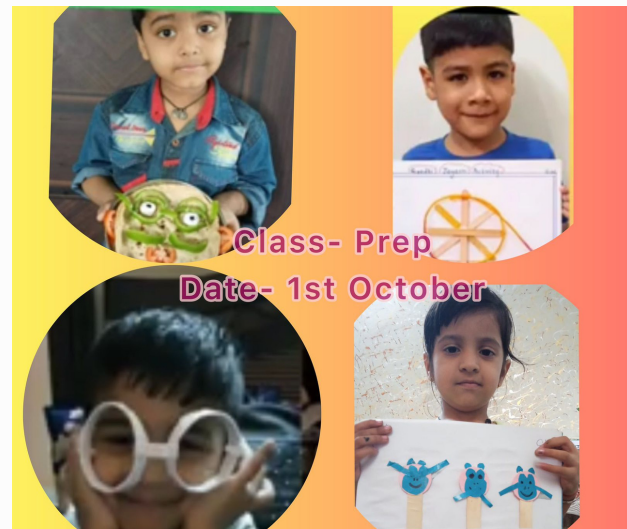
# Gandhi Jayanti Celebration

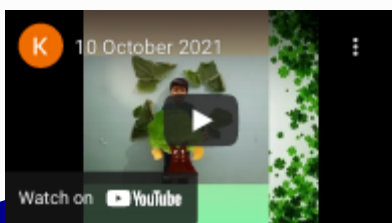


# Green Color Day Celebration

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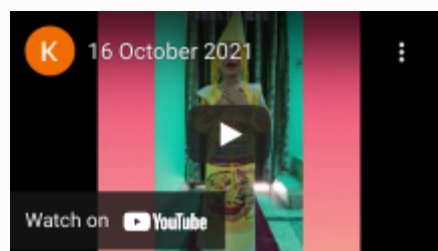


# World Food Day

# Durga Puja

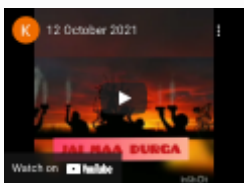
Durga Puja is celebrated massively all over India. We worship Goddess Durga, who killed Mahishasura, symbolizing the victory over evil.

Children thoroughly enjoyed both the activities with great zeal and devotion.



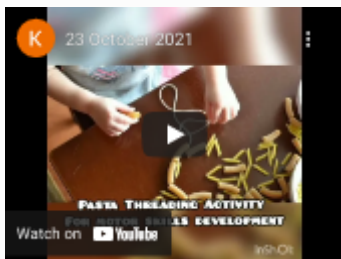

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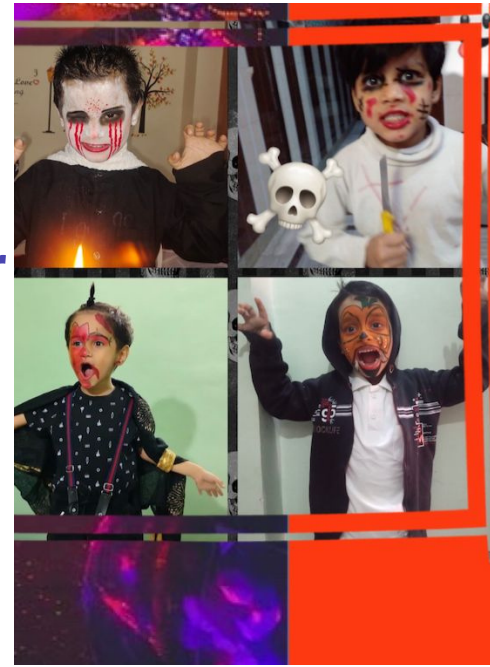

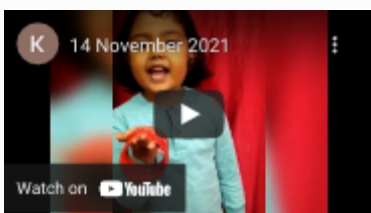

# Safety On Road Week

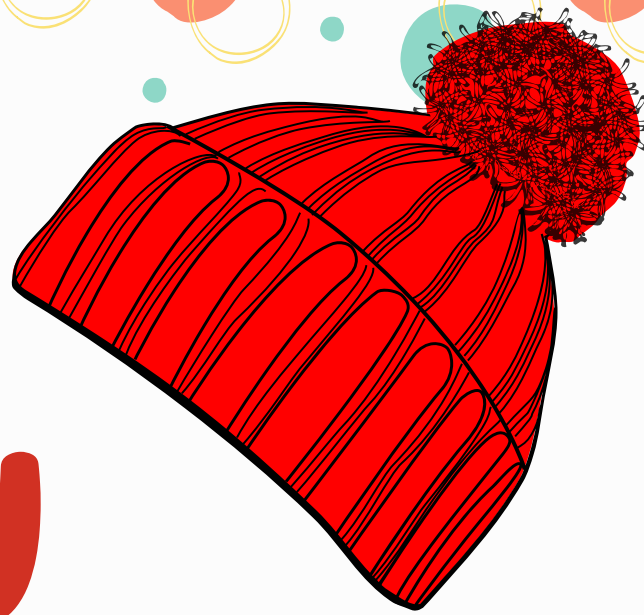

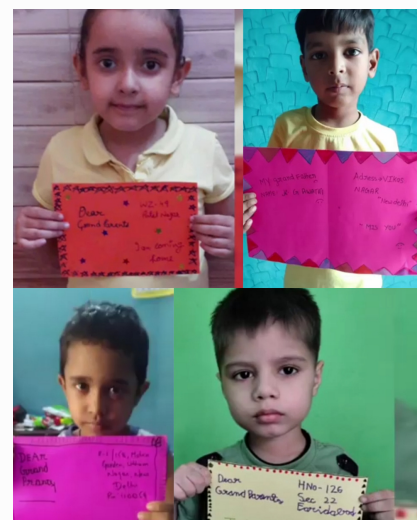


# World Postal Day

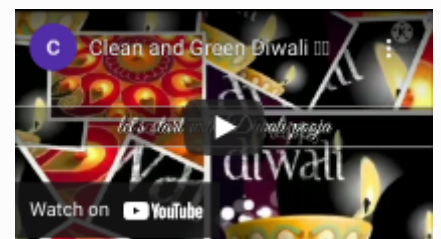




# DIWALI CRAFT

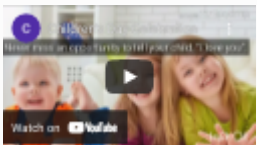


# Children's Day Activity

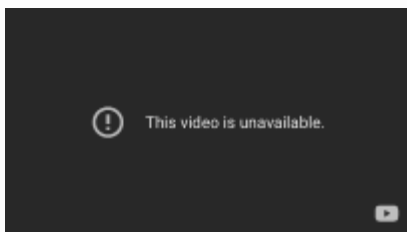
# World Kindness Day

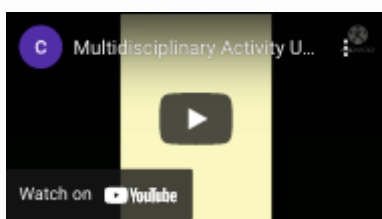
# Multidisciplinary Bagless- Happy Days Activity

# Gurupurab Celebration

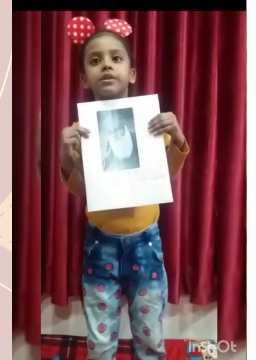
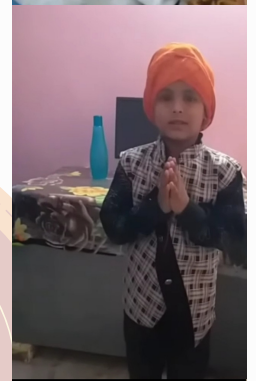


**“ Nanak Pragtya, miti dhund jag

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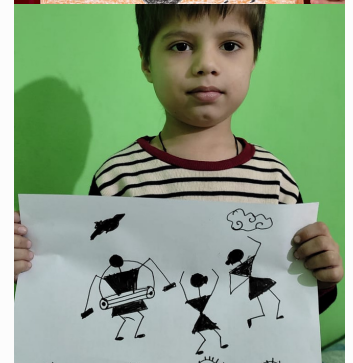
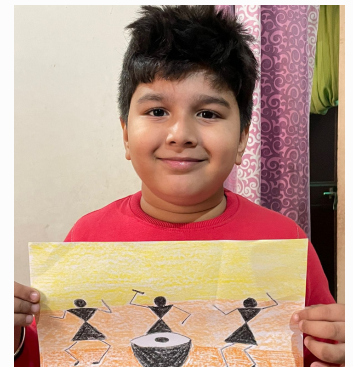
# VIRTUAL TOUR TO MAHARASHTRA

**Mahatma Gandhi dreamt of an India which was not only free but also clean and developed. As an Indian citizen it is our duty to make our country clean and green.**

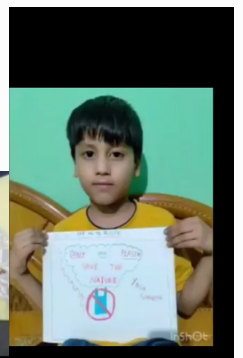
**To mark this day , a Special Assembly was organized under the campaign**

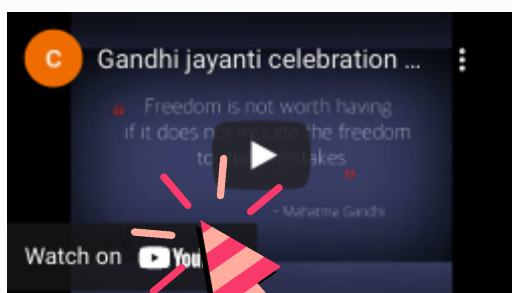

Date - 1/10/2021

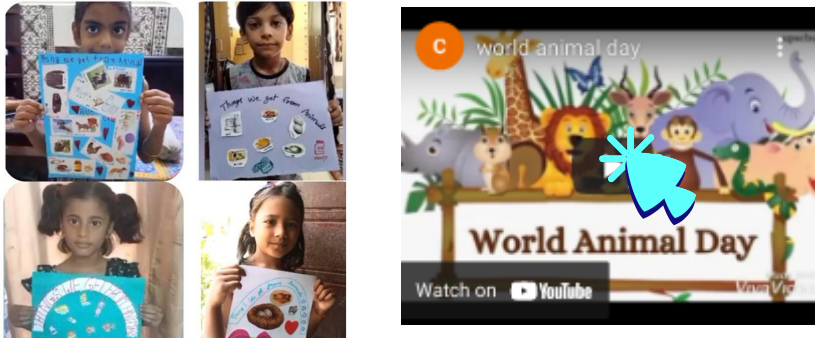

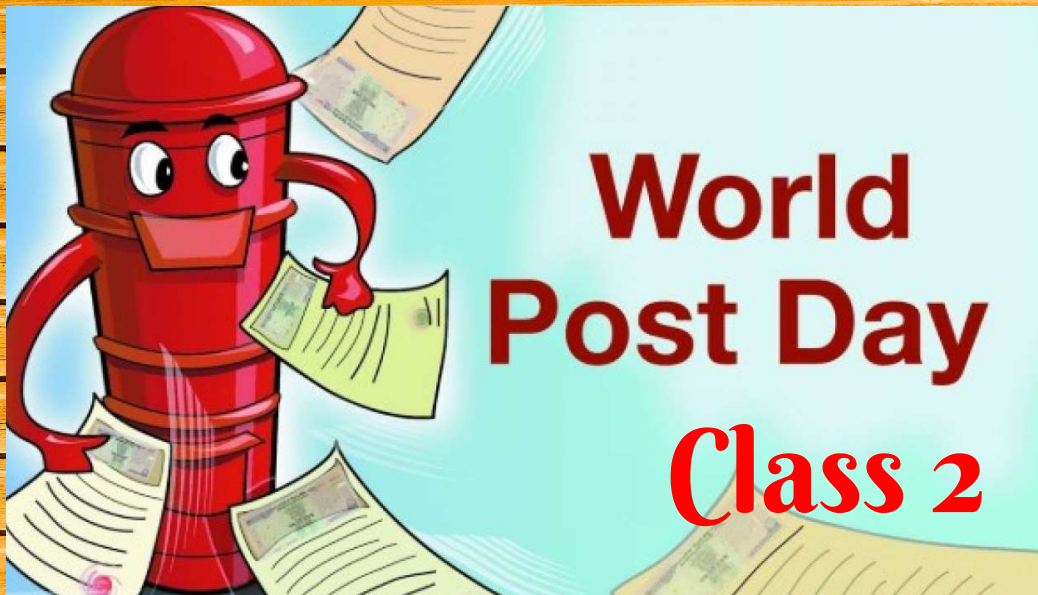

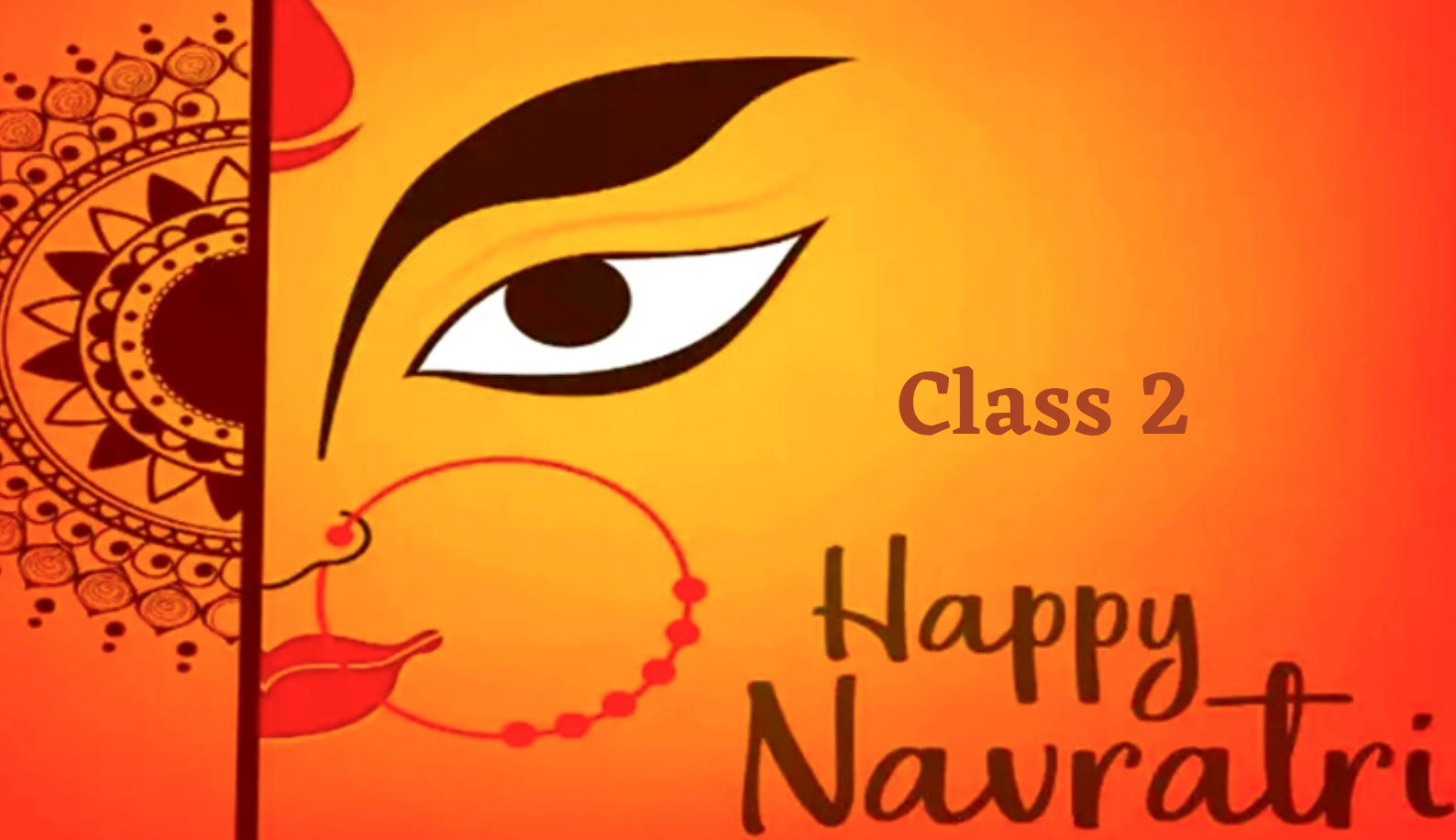


On the World Post Day students acknowledged the Postal service by writing and posting letters to their families and friends.

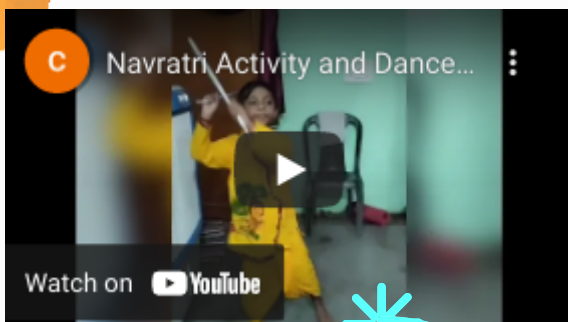

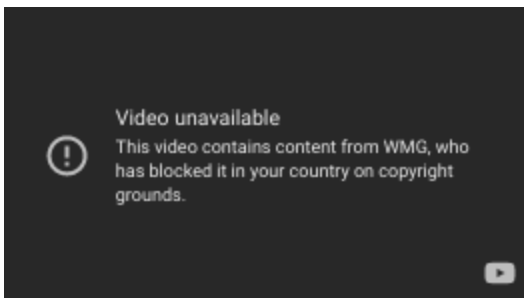
Date - 30/10/21

Date - 3/11/2021

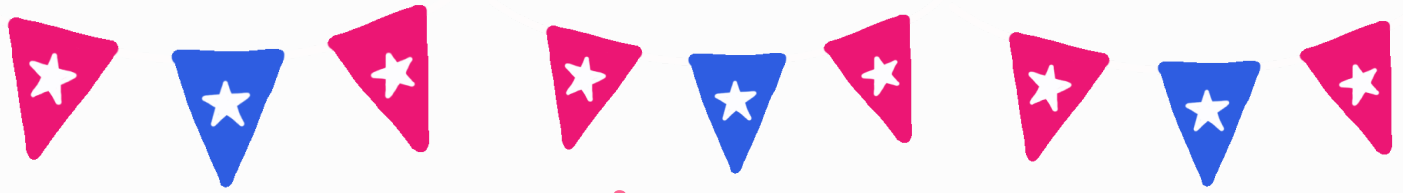
Diwali celebrations illuminated everyone's heart with joy and fervour. The day comprised of a bunch of exhilarating activities.

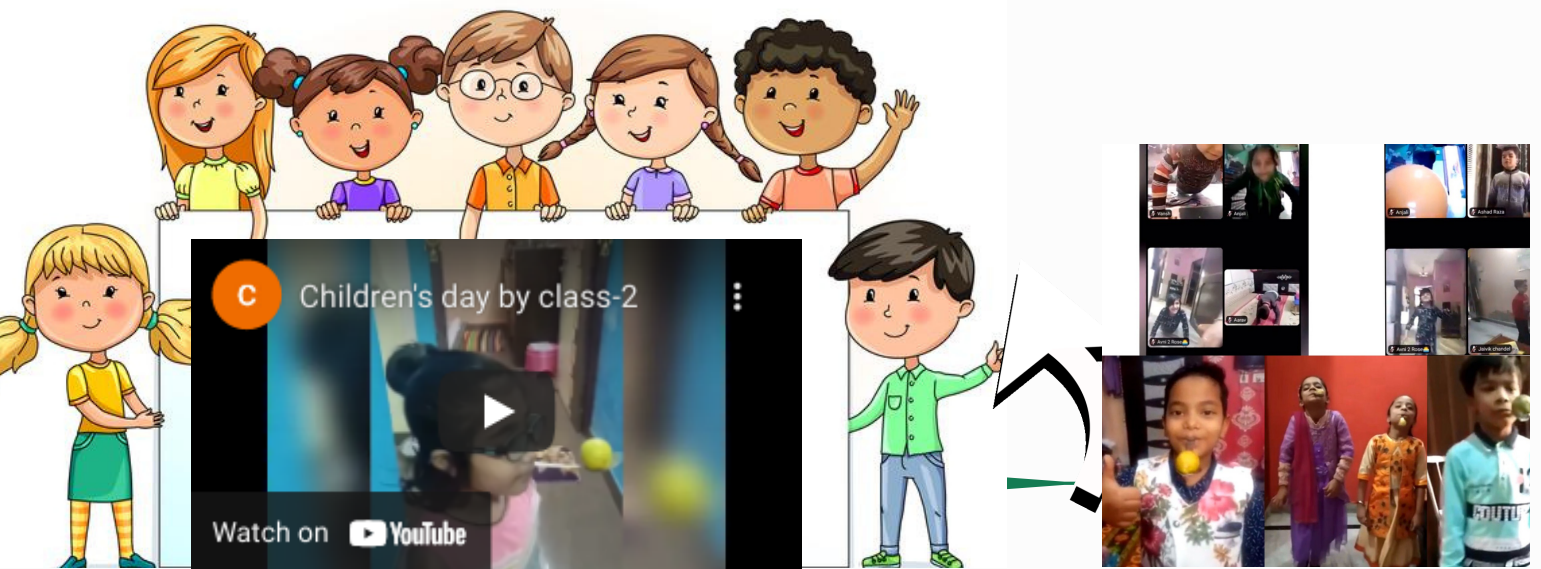
# Children's Day

Date - 15/11/2021

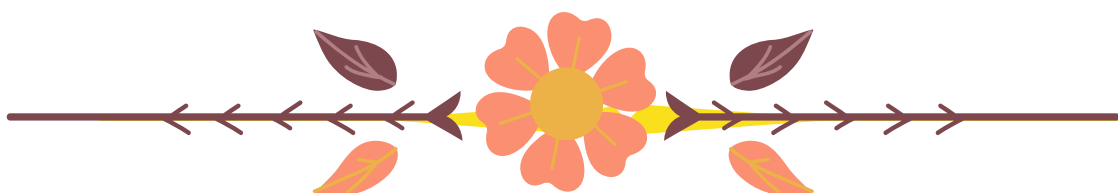

It was fascinating and exciting for the students as it also developed their critical thinking, creativity, and motor skills.

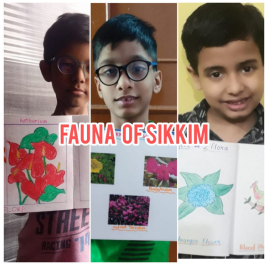




# Virtual Tour To Sikkim

## The Changing Role Of A 21st Century Educator

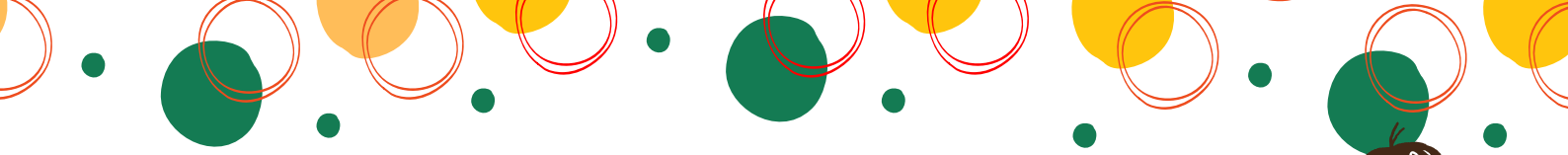
