



The outbreak of corona virus has made unbelievable changes. There is a need to strengthen our education models and welcome technology into our lives.




As we know the art of practicing Yoga helps in controlling an individual's body, mind and soul.




Maths Model of Coordinate Geometry






































MATHS ACTIVITY (XII CLASS)
