#### VISION



















### RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENTS




























### **RED & WHITE COLOUR DAY**






### Mixing of Primary Colours




Little munchkins of class 1 made different Christmas Crafts .Kids were excited and enjoyed doing their activity.


### **LOHRI CELEBRATION**

# From the Teacher's Heart

### Mother Tongue to be instated as medium of instruction:

Home is the first classroom for a child. When a child enters a structured learning environment in the form of the school, there is already a tremendous amount of adjustment and adaptation going on. Now, imagine starting school and not able to understand the teacher! There can be no greater stress on a child than this. Having to understand a foreign language while already going through other major changes impedes the learning process .When the medium of instruction is the mother tongue or local language, the child will learn concepts faster, adjust better, and show gains in learning quicker. This extends to parental participation in schooling, as well. In India, due to a lack of fluency in English, parental participation is sometimes limited. A switch to the mother tongue would potentially create a much stronger school -parent partnership which, in turn, would help in laying a rock-solid foundation for a child's education. - **Bharti** 

#### Parental responsibilities in the Special Education:

Some of the following suggestions may be helpful to the parents:

- Develop a partnership with the school and share relevant information about your child's education and development.
- Ask for clarification of any aspect of the program that is unclear to you.
- Make sure you understand the program specified in the IEP or IFSP before agreeing to it or signing the form. Take the IEP or IFSP form home to review it before you sign it.
- Consider and discuss with your child's teacher how your child might be included in the regular school activities program.
- Monitor your child's progress and periodically ask for a report.
- Discuss with the school any problems that occur with your child's assessment, placement, or educational program.
- Keep records of all the discussions, meetings as well as phone conversations you want to remember.
- Join a parent organization to share knowledge and gain support.

## From the Teacher's Heart

#### **Impact of NEP on policy on Preschool**

The National Education Policy is very promising and futuristic which takes into consideration that the first 1000 days are very crucial for the child. Therefore, the right kind of early childhood environment is very important for each child. The gap between the existing learning outcomes and the outcomes which are actually required, must be bridged by undertaking major reforms that bring the highest quality, equity, and integrity into the system, right from early childhood care and education through higher education. Currently, children in the age group of 3-6 are not covered in the 10+2 structure as Class 1 begins at age 6. However, the new National Education Policy is based on 5+3+3+4 structure wherein a strong base of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) from age 3 is also included. – Geetanjali

### Schooling to begin from the age of 3 years.

The best age to start pre-school is considered to be 3 years. Kindergarten school is considered to be the first stepping stone in to the world o formal education.



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
### **Importance of Homework**
