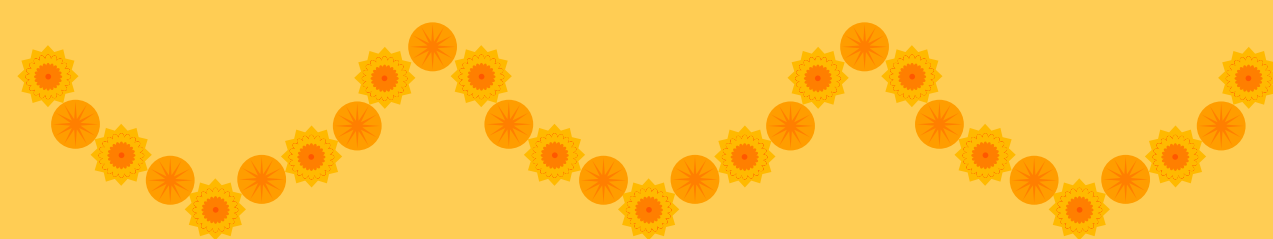

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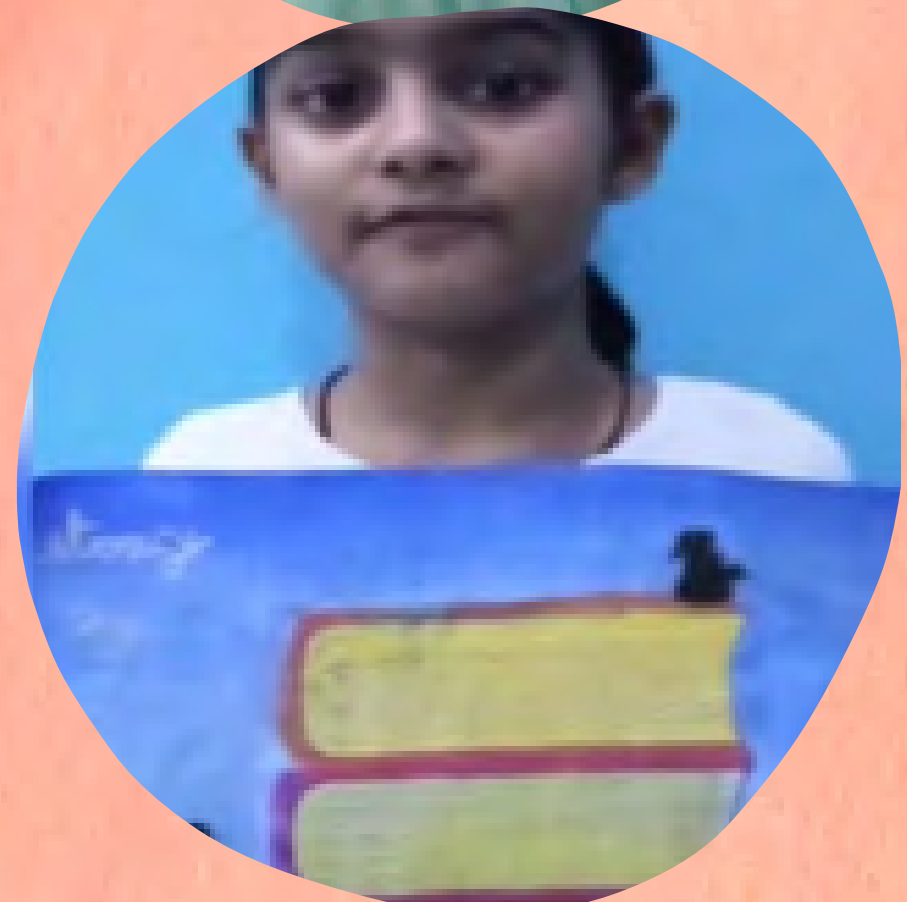
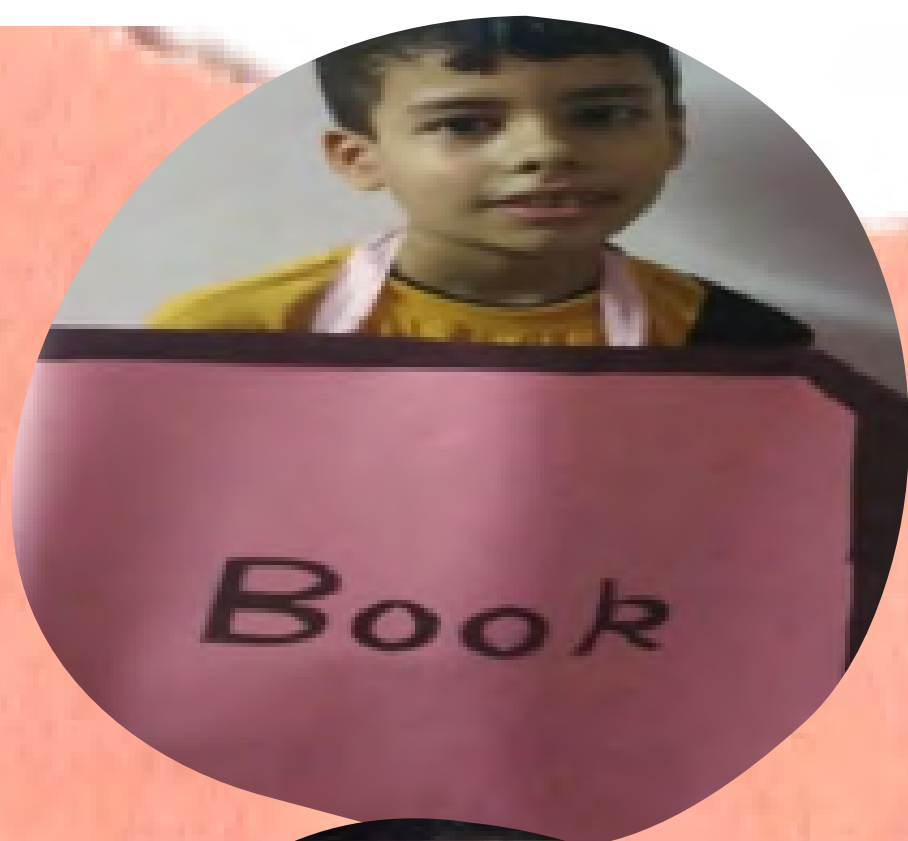
INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY

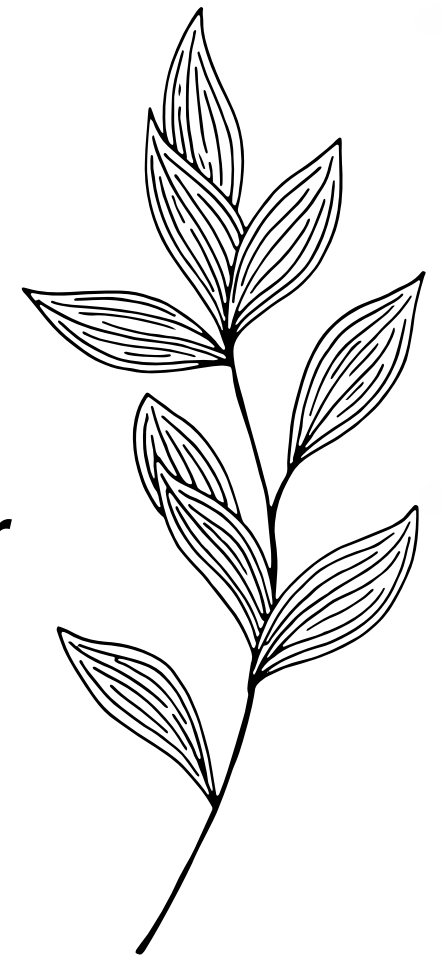
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GRANDPARENTS' DAY

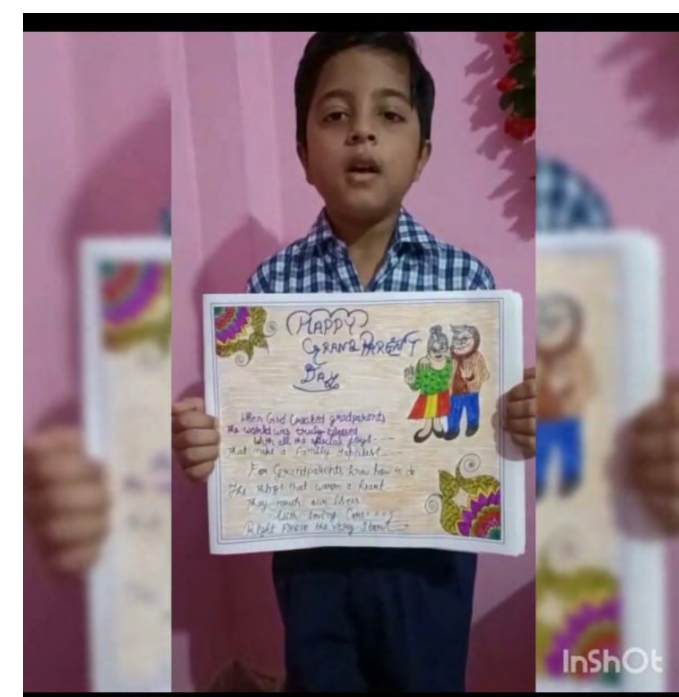

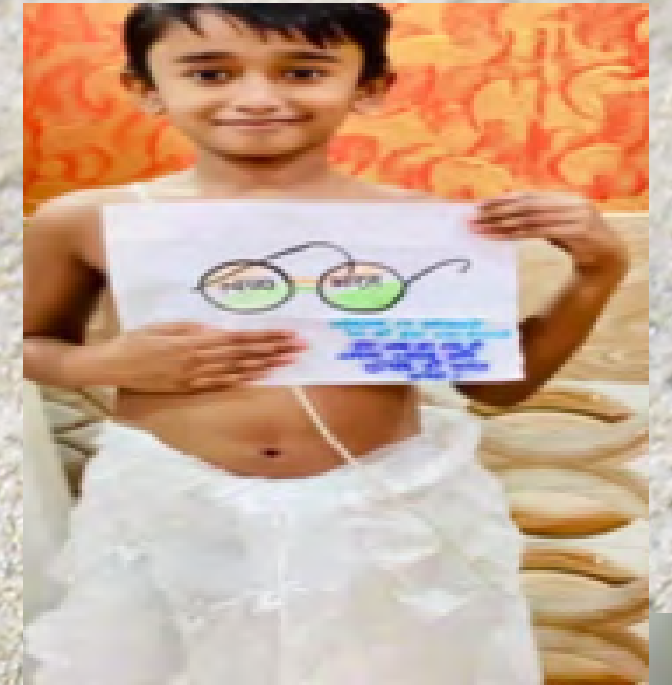


Gandhi & Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti(2 Oct)

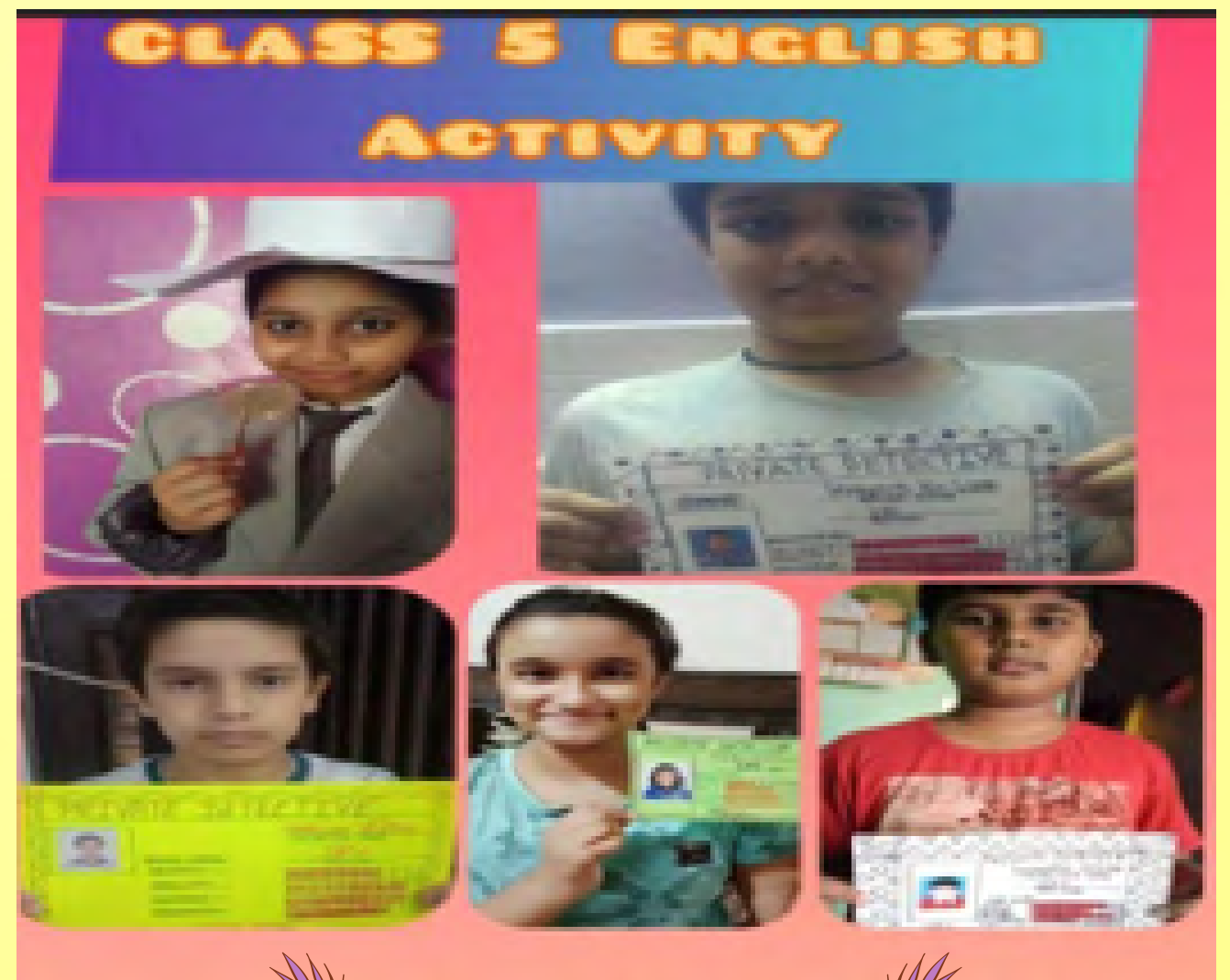
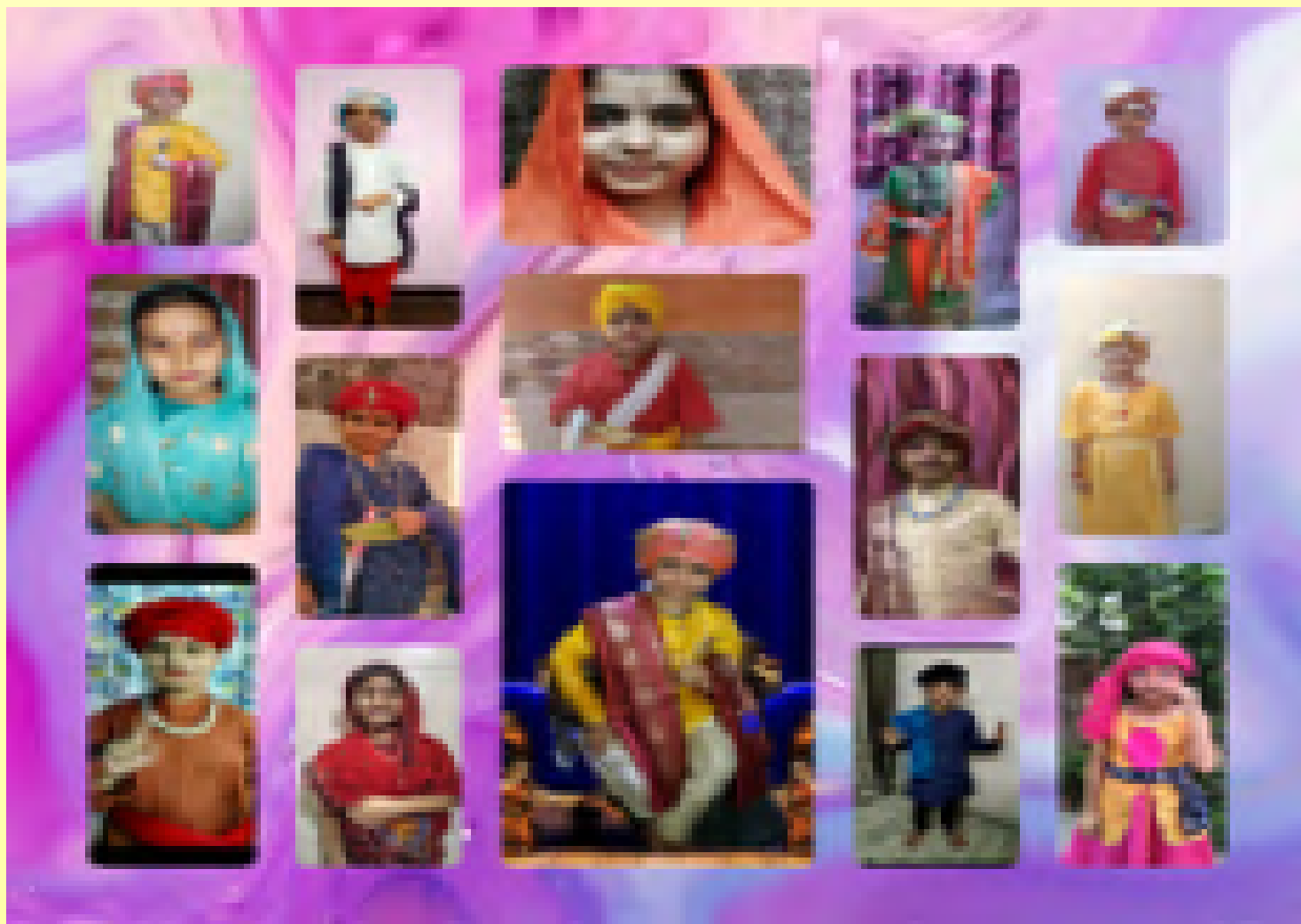
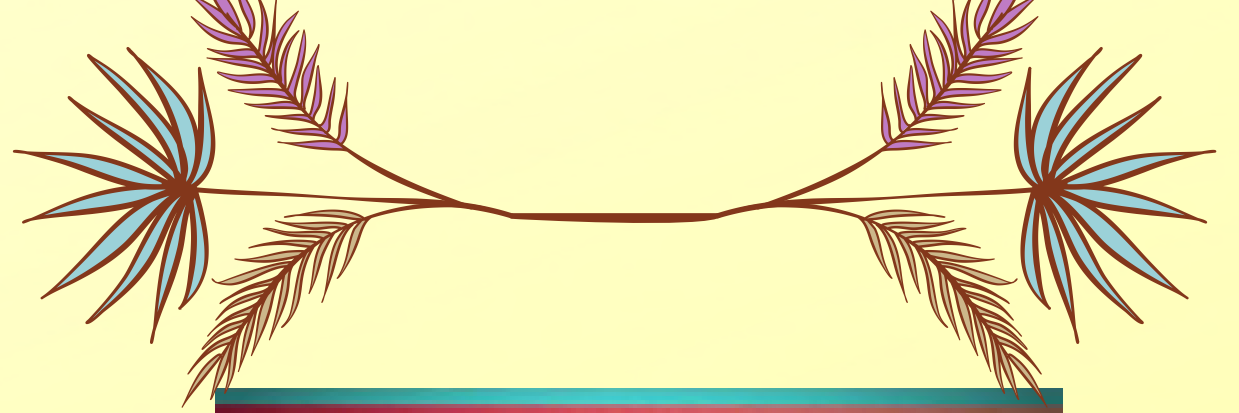

ओरछा की रामलीला

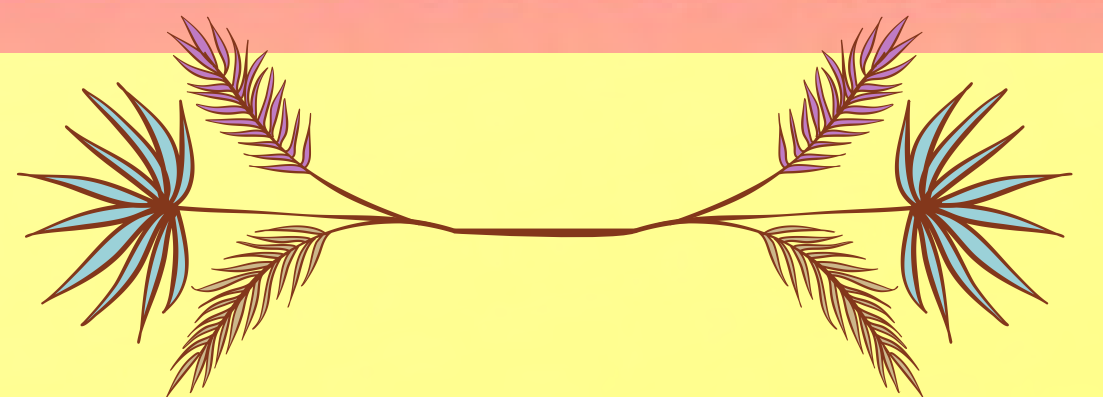

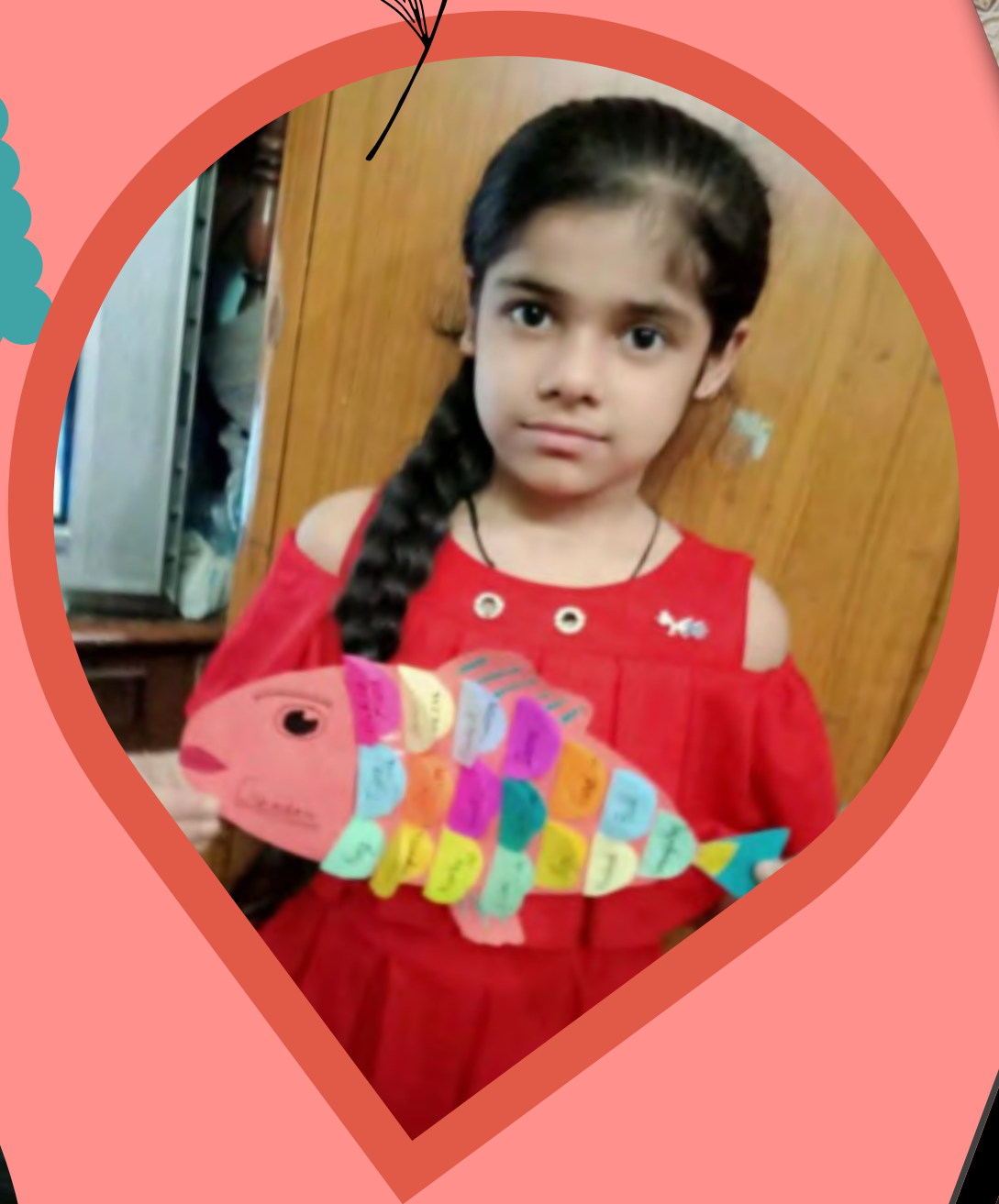
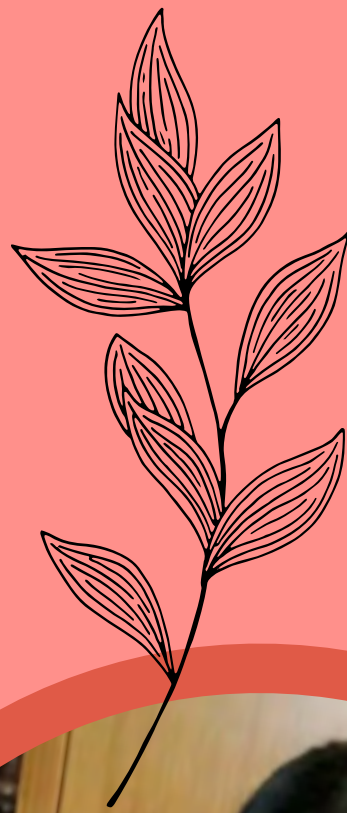


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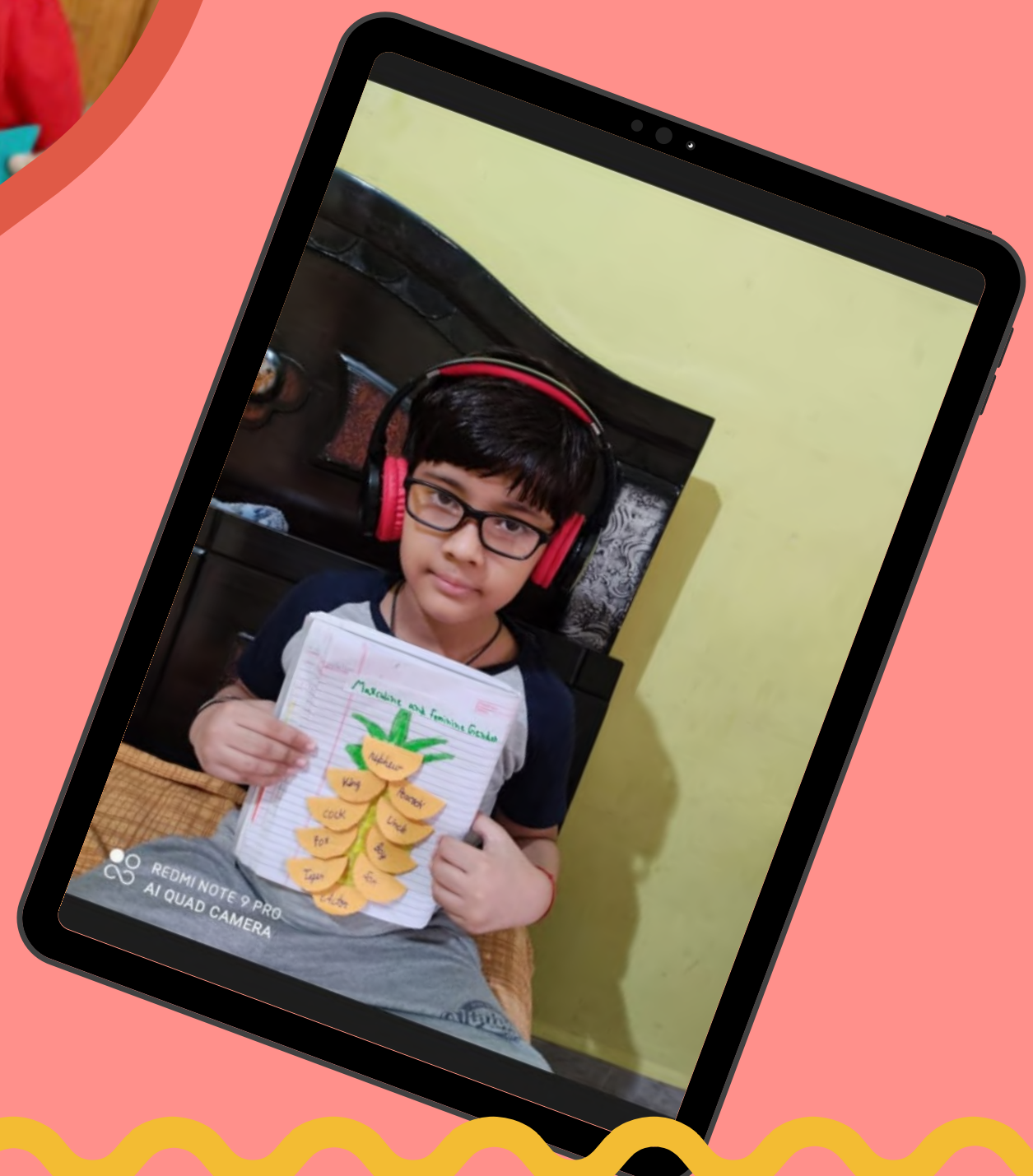


Gender Fish Activity

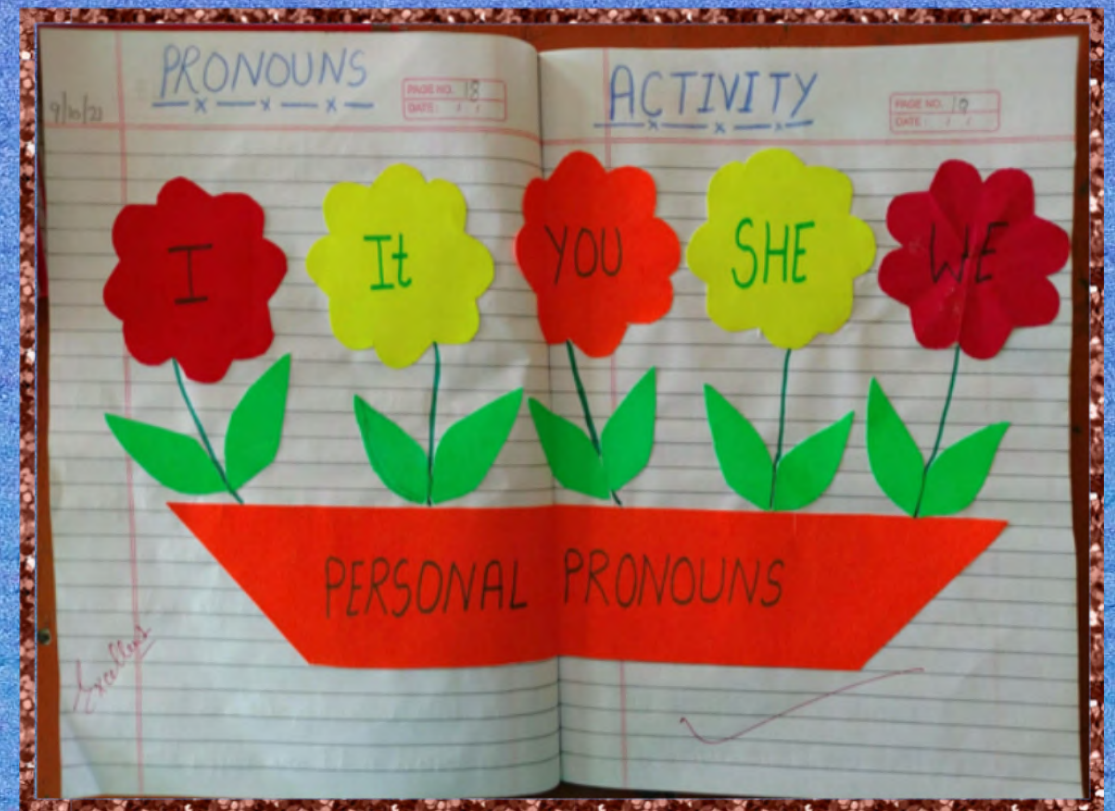

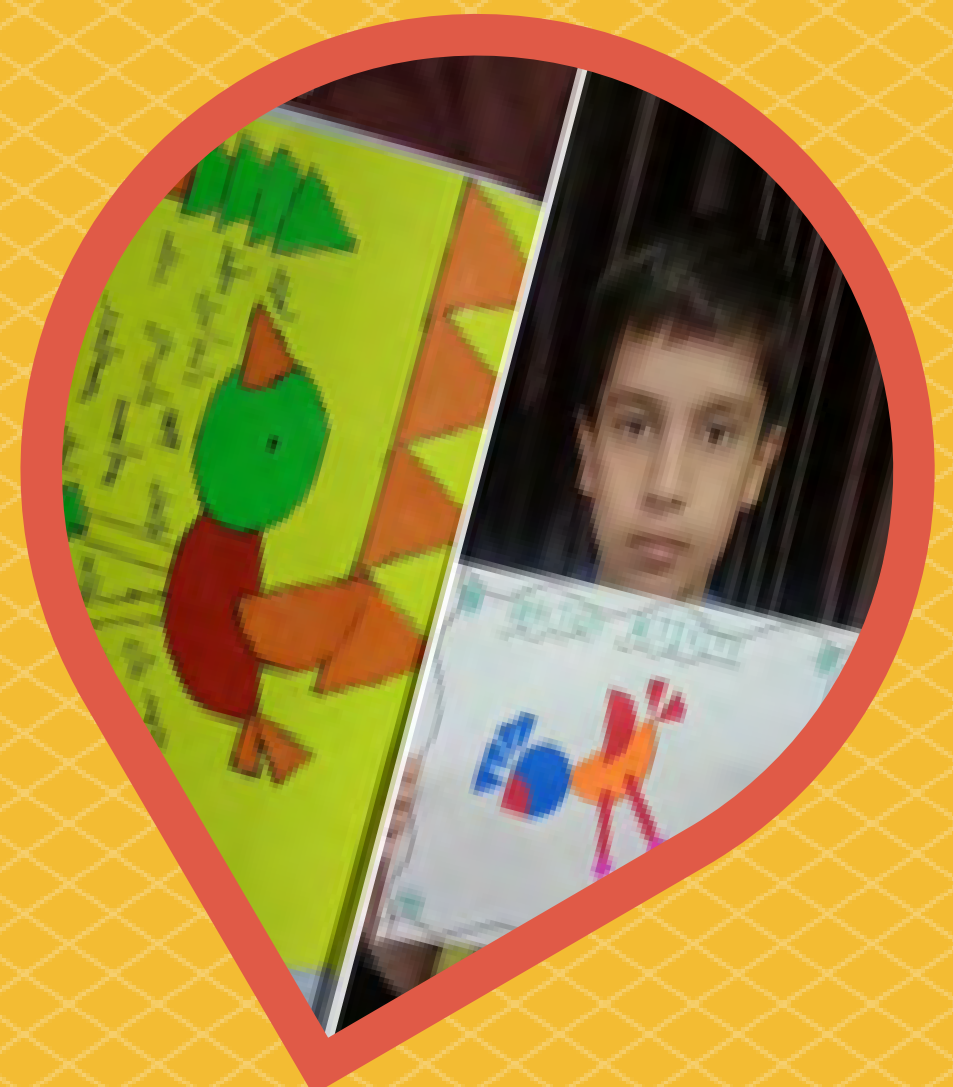


Maths Club

They showed their positive attitude towards the learning and explained the colourful culture and tradition of RAJASTHAN.

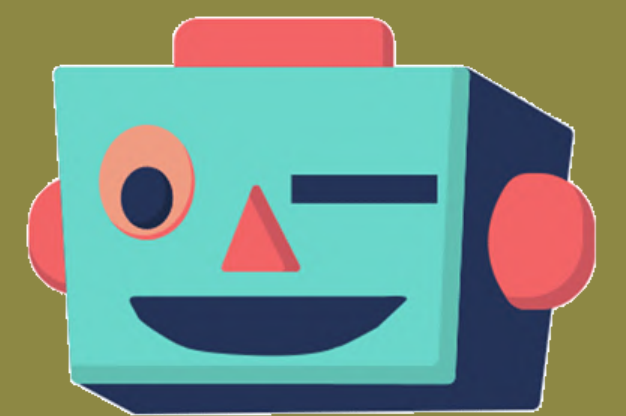
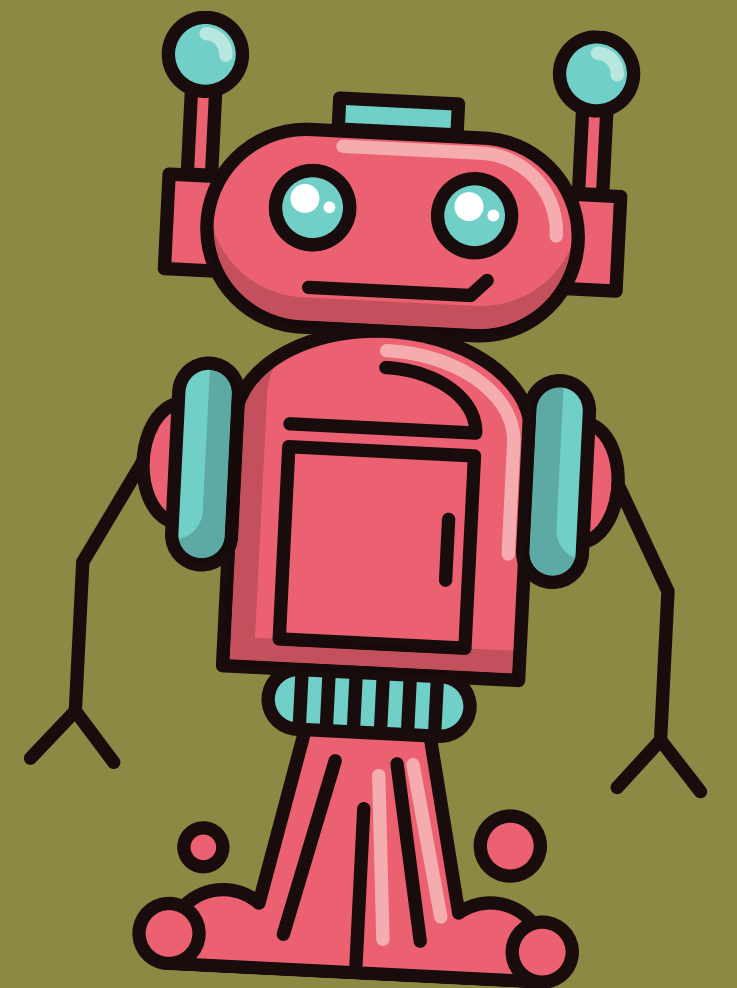
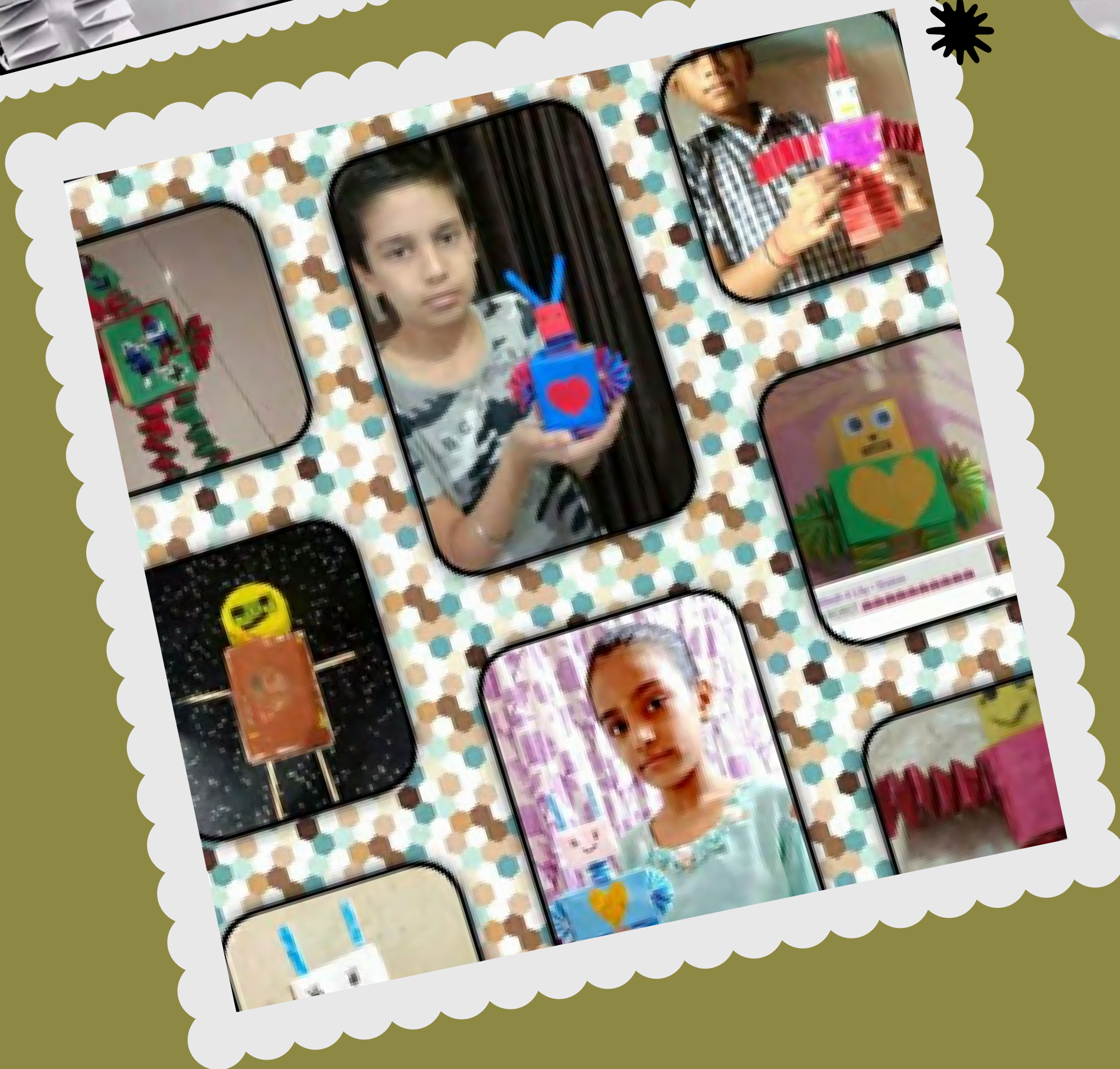
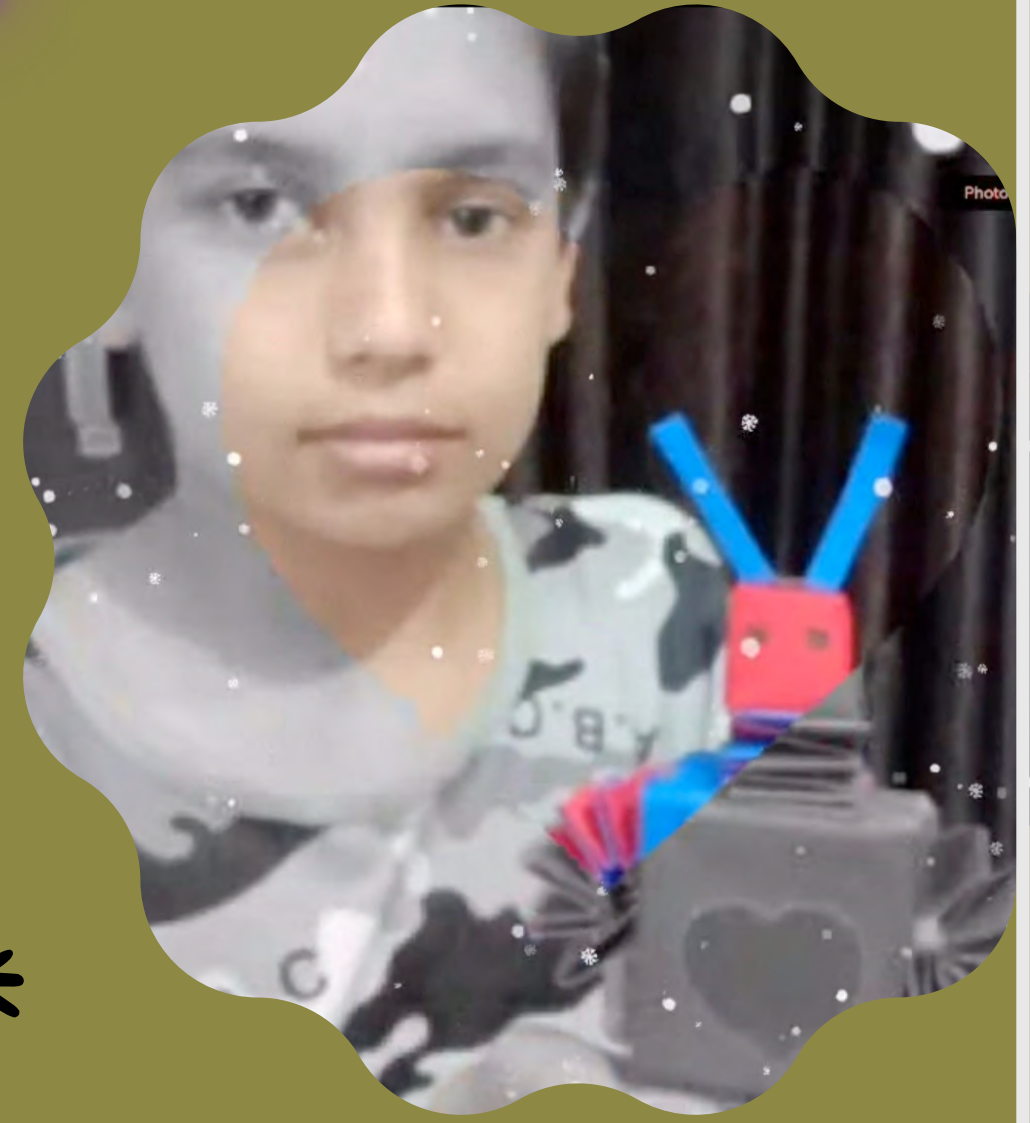
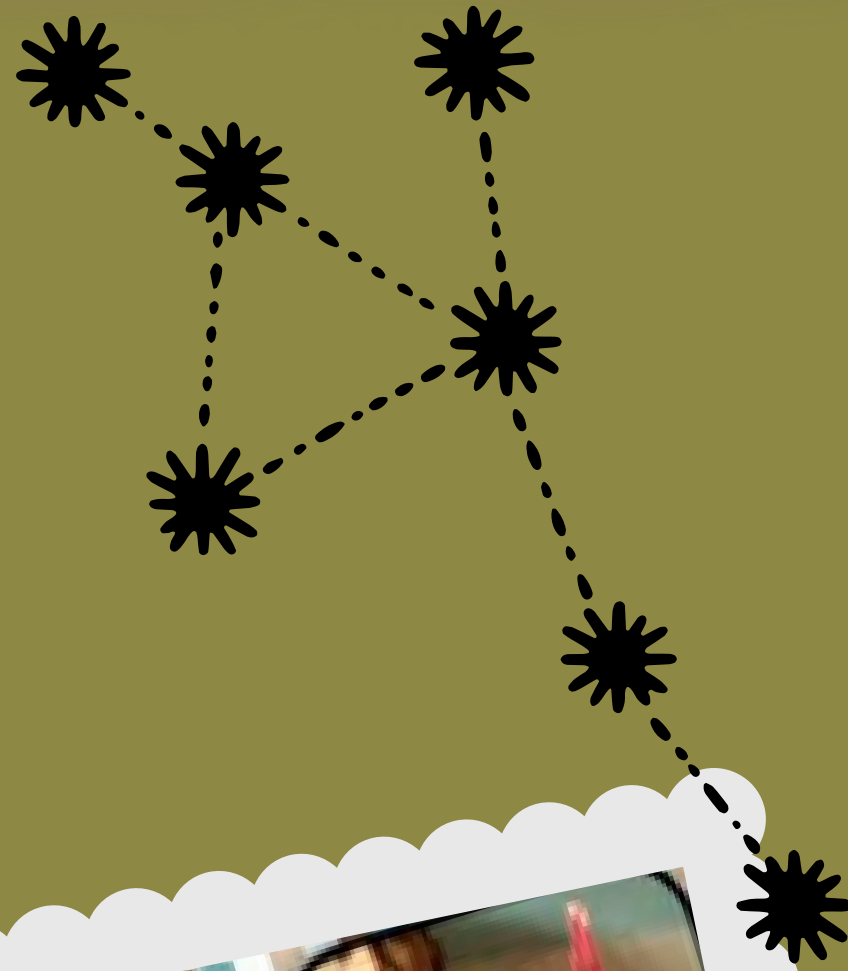

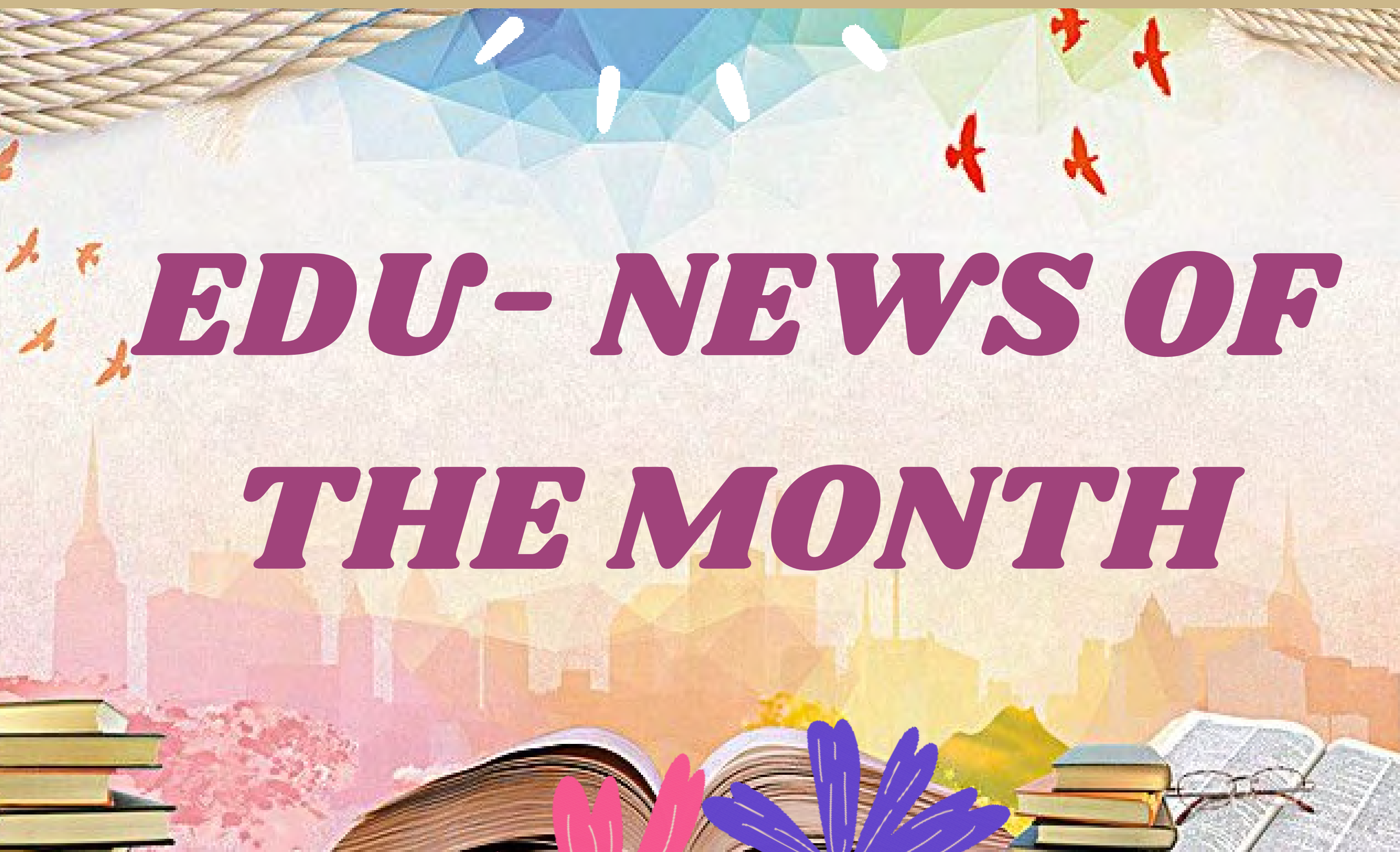
KMS E- Library

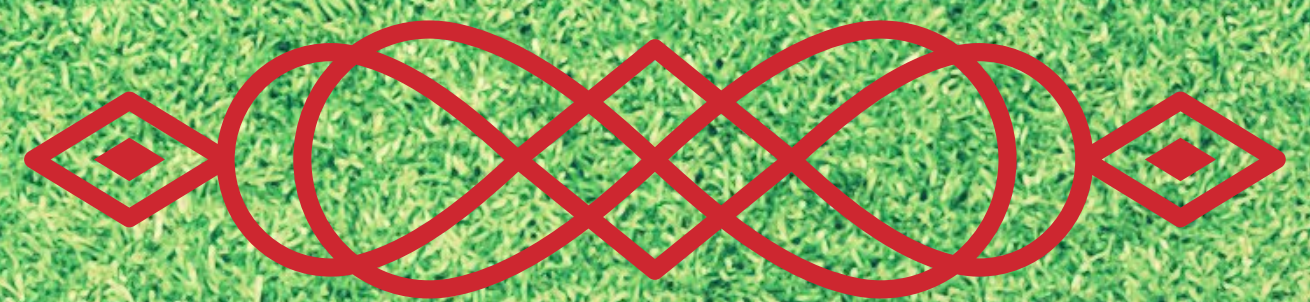


SAFAL - Structured Assessment For Analysing Learning)

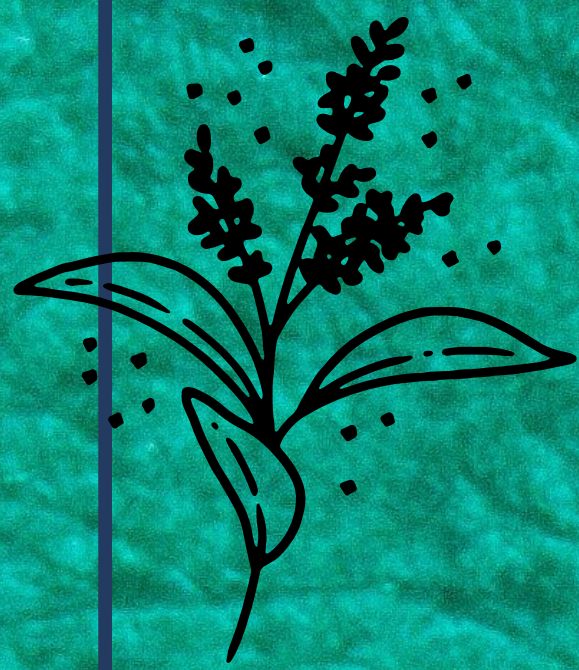

To encourage the students to widen their knowledge in different areas, Kamal Model Sr Sec school had organized various Online Quiz Competitions for the primary students.

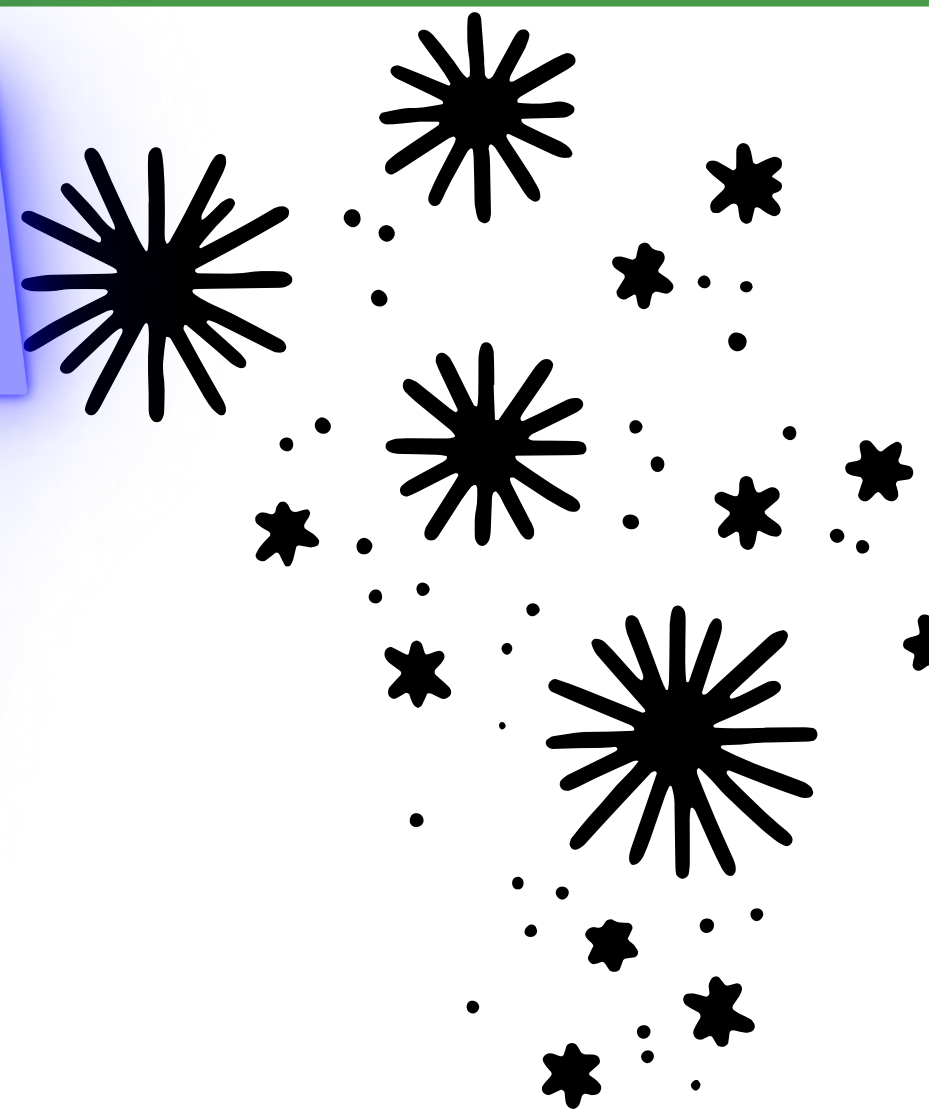
All the students & teachers wholeheartedly participated in the quiz and received certificates.

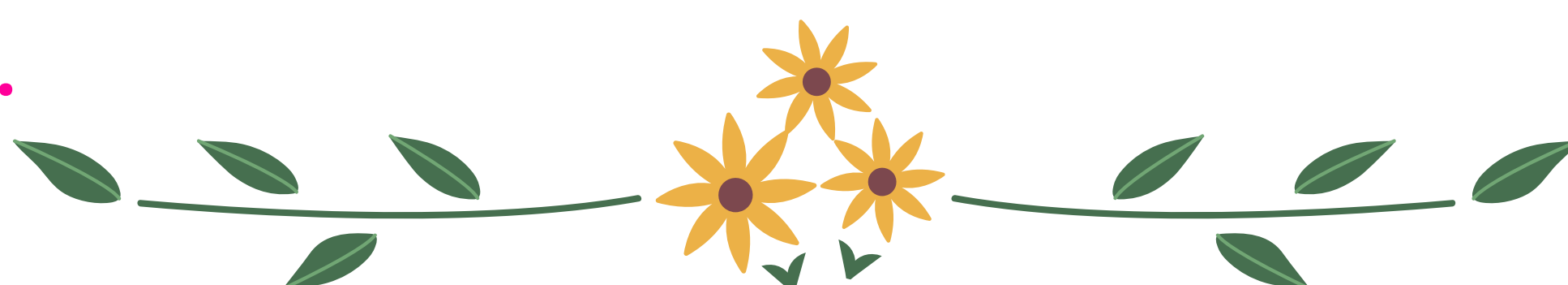

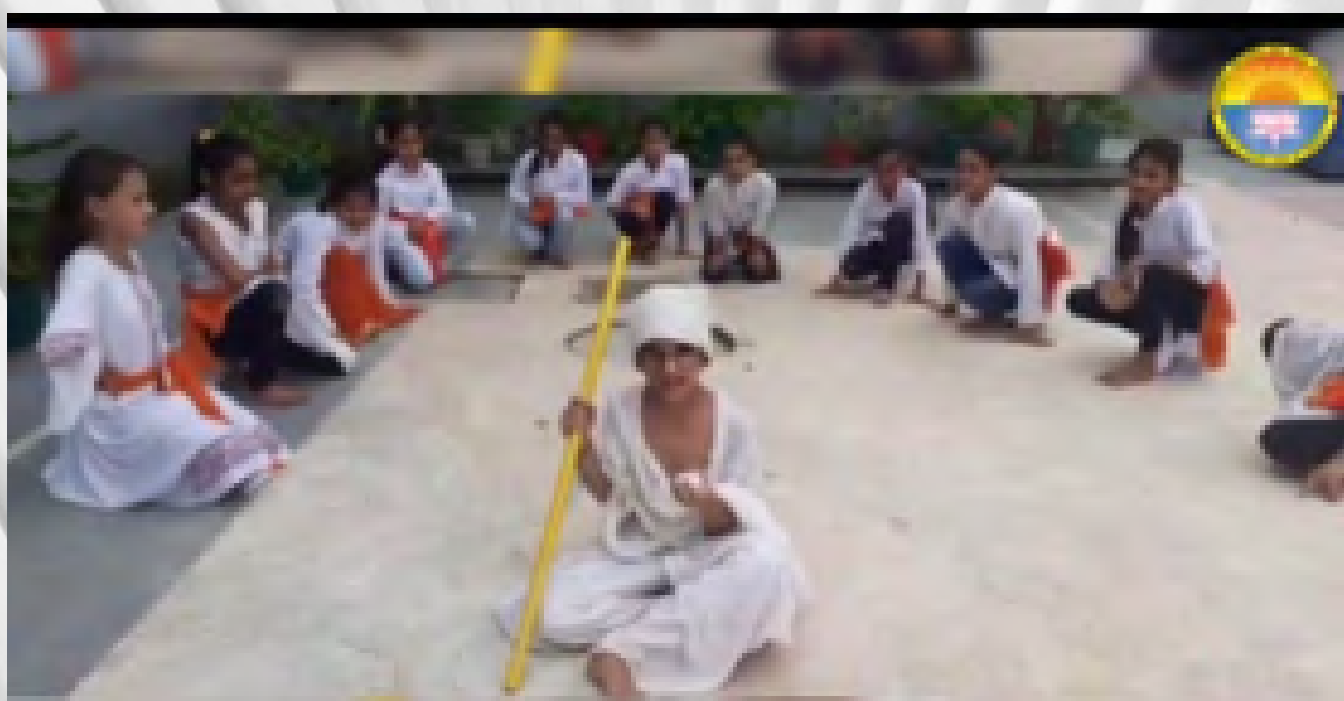
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Swacch Bharat Abhiyaan - NUKKAD NATAK

In order to ensure community mobilisation and bolster people's participation, every year, the month of September is celebrated as PoshanMaah across the country.

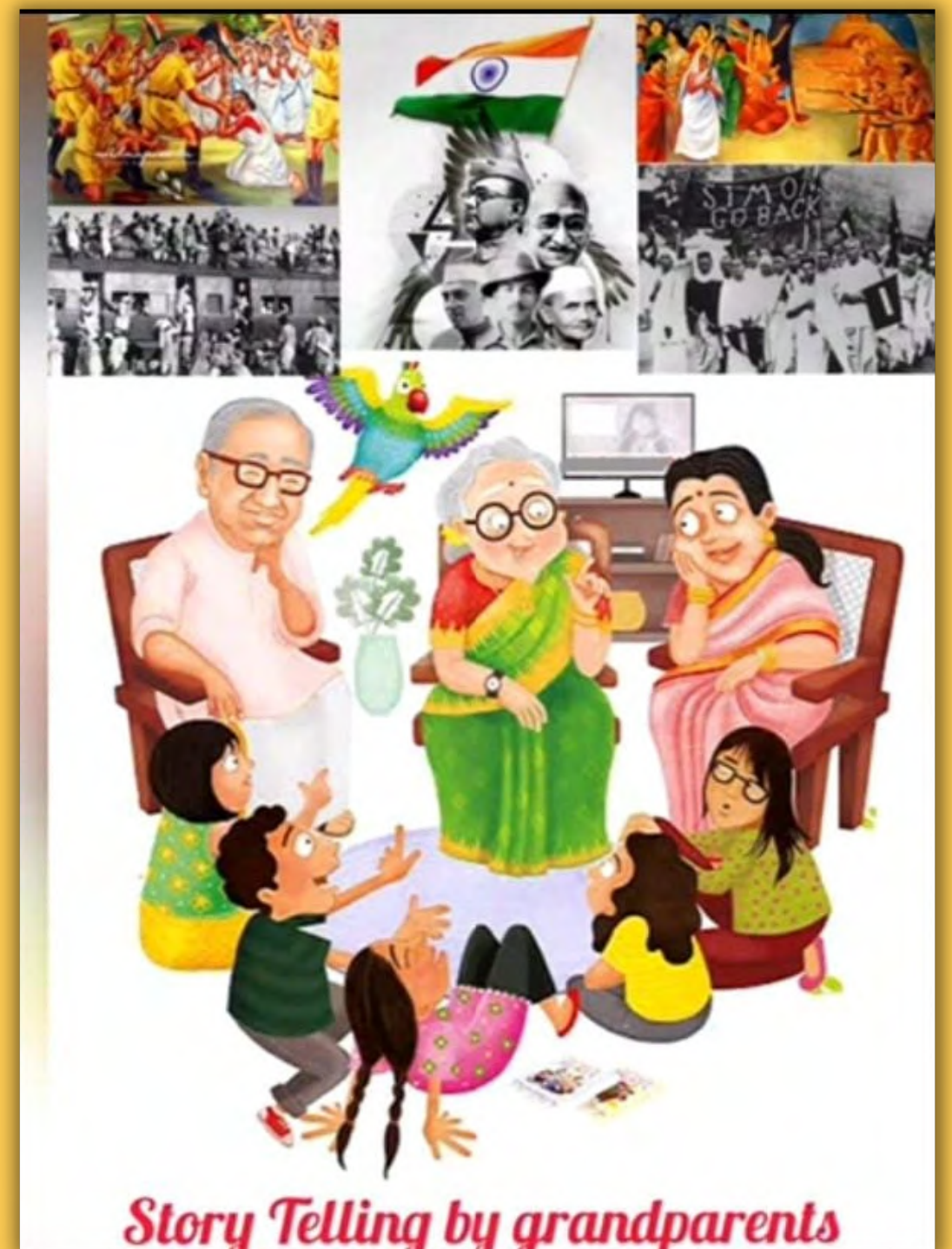

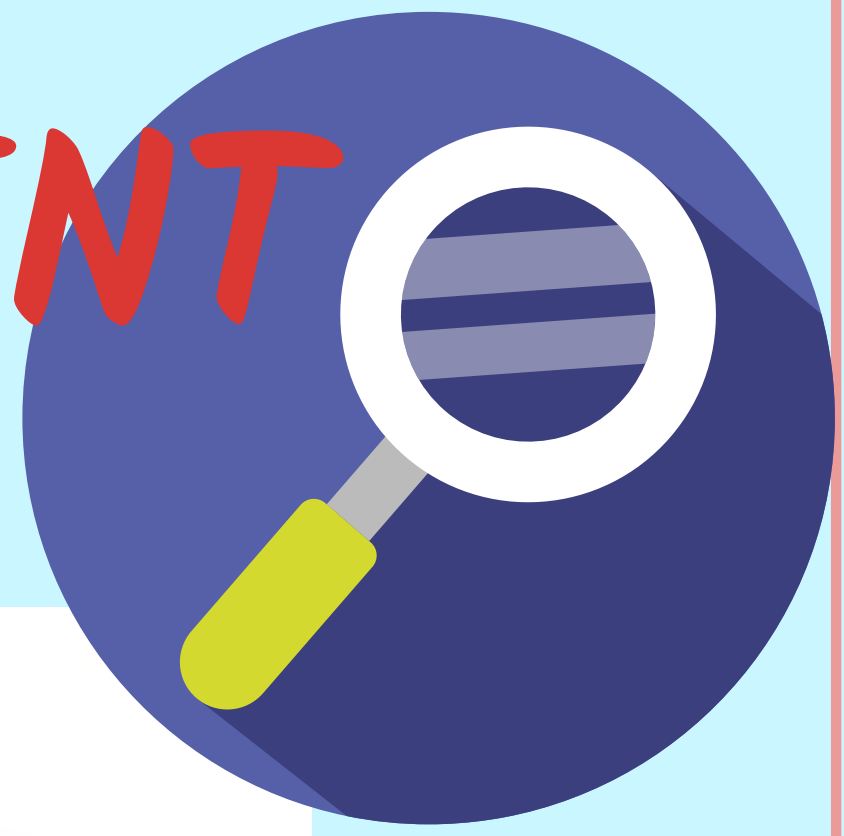
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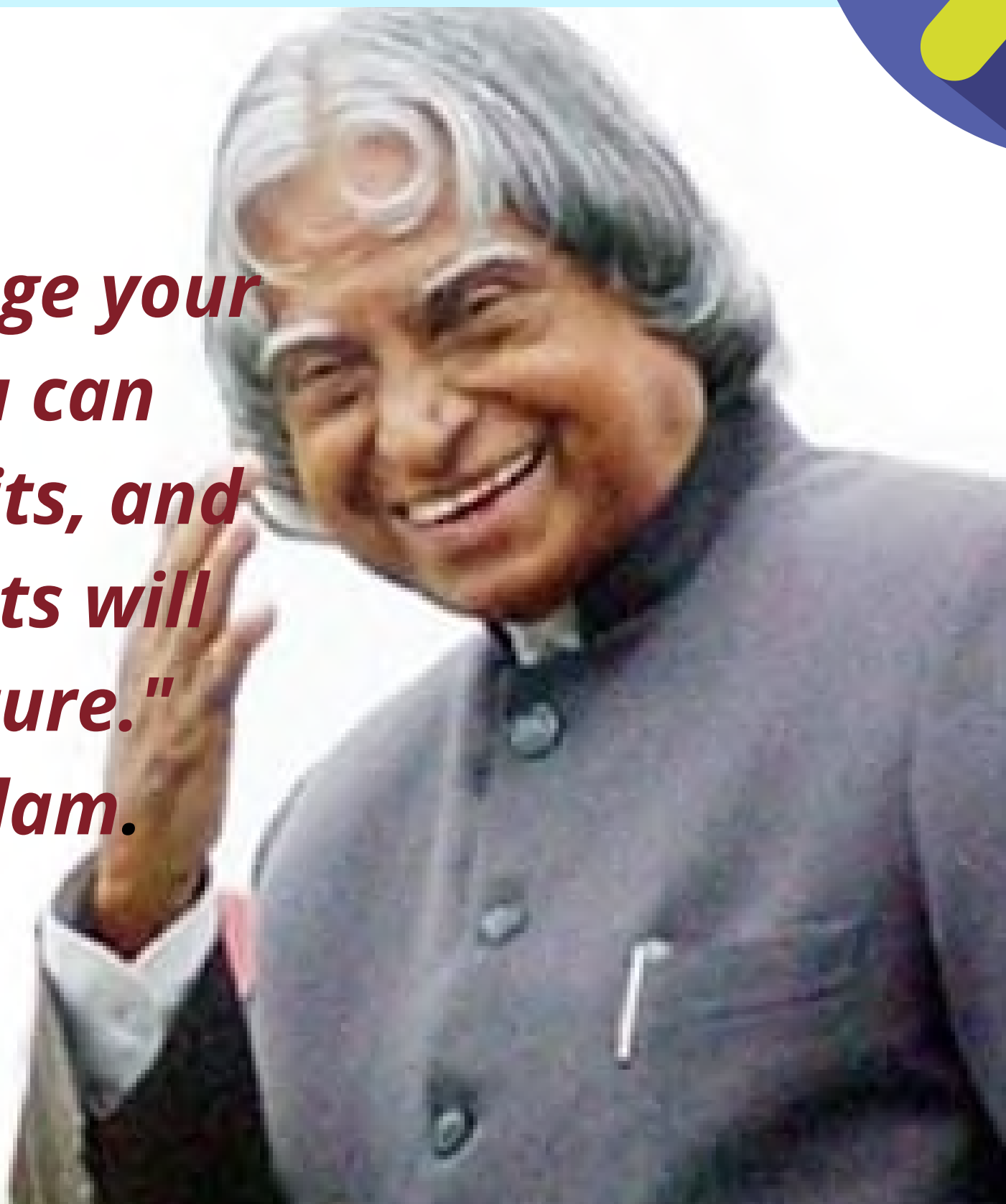
P A R E N T I N G T I P S
