




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PUTTING MIND TO MATHS

CLASS JAD SKIRFTY KILDS Children observed the parent (1)




ELECTRO UNIVERSE



PLASTIC MUKT BHAARAT





To create poster for spreading awareness.


Students celebrated the environment day and enjoyed alot.


