

























World Book Of Records









SUSTAINABLE LIVING








TOURISM (Market Market Market










India is honoured to be at the forefront of popularising millets. Millet consumption further enhances nutrition, food security and welfare of farmers.



सीबीएसई गवर्निंग बॉडी की सदस्य एवं कमल मॉडल सीनियर सैकेंडरी स्कूल की प्रधानाचार्या डॉ. वंदना टण्डन ने नई शिक्षा नीति के बारे में अपने विचार व्यक्त करते हुए कहा कि नई शिक्षा नीति के तहत शिक्षा प्रणाली में होने वाले बदलावों से छात्रों को लाभ तो होगा, किन्तु छात्रों की स्किल्स पर अधिक ध्यान दिया जाना चाहिए। शिक्षा का उद्देश्य बच्चों का सम्पूर्ण व्यक्तित्व विकास है। उन्होंने कहा कि 10वीं और 12वीं कक्षा के छात्रों के लिए बोर्ड की परीक्षाएं दो बार आयोजित किए जाने के निर्णय से

उन छात्रों को लाभ होगा जो किसी भी कारणवश परीक्षा में पीछे रह जाएं अथवा कम अंक प्राप्त कर पाए हों। इसके अलावा वे बच्चे जिनकी पर्सेन्टेज कम हो, उन्हें भी अपनी पर्सेन्टेज में सुधार करने का अवसर प्राप्त होगा। उन्होंने कहा कि शिक्षकों को मैनेज करने में थोड़ी परेशानी आ सकती है। परीक्षा के समय डेढ़ से दो महीने के समय में किस प्रकार से बदलाव करके मैनेज किया जाएगा, उस पर अभी प्रश्न चिन्ह है। स्ट्रीम सिस्टम को हटाए जाने के विषय पर उन्होंने कहा कि इस सिस्टम के समाप्त होने से छात्र अपनी पसन्द के अन्य विषयों को चुन सकेंगे। यह नई शिक्षा नीति छात्रों के लिए फायदेमंद ही होगी। उन्होंने कहा कि मेरे विचार से बच्चों की स्किल्स पर अधिक ध्यान देने से उनका भविष्य निर्माण अच्छे से होगा क्योंकि बच्चा अपनी स्कूली शिक्षा तो पूरी कर लेता है किन्तु उसके बाद उसे स्किल्स की ही अधिक आवश्यकता होती है।
