**कालिदास जी का आरंभिक जीवन**

साहित्य के विद्वान और महाकवि कालिदास का जन्म कब और कहाँ हुआ इसके बारे में अभी तक कुछ भी स्पष्ट नहीं है। लेकिन इनके जन्म को लेकर विद्वानों के अलग-अलग मत हैं।

ऐसा माना जाता है कि 150 ईसा पूर्व 450 ईस्वी तक कालिदास रहे होंगे। जबकि एक रिसर्च के मुताबिक कालिदास गुप्त काल में जन्मे होंगे। चूंकि कालिदास ने, द्वितीय शताब्दी के अविनाशिक को नायक बनाकर "आलविकाविजयिन्" नामक निखा और अविनाशिक ने 170 ईसापूर्व में शासन किया था जिससे कालिदास के जन्म का अनुमान लगाया जा सकता है।

छठी सदी में बाणभट्ट ने अपनी रचना "हर्षचरितम्" में कालिदास का उल्लेख किया है तथा इसी काल के पुलकेशिन द्वितीय के पहले अधिवेष में कालिदास का जिक्र है आखिरकार वे इनके बाद के नहीं हो सकते। इस तरह कालिदास के पद्यों का आरंभ 150 ईसा पूर्व से तीसरी शताब्दी ईस्वी के बीच के जन्म माने जाते हैं।

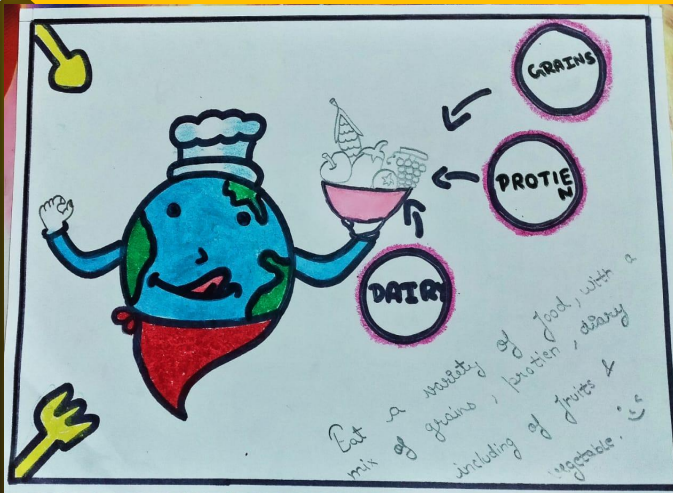
# Happy Vegetarian Day

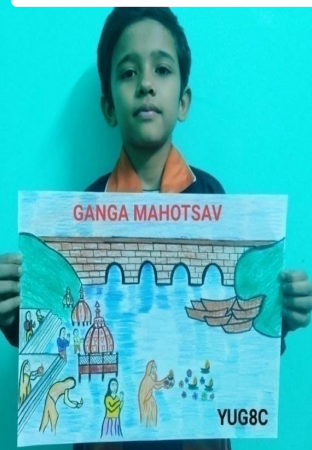

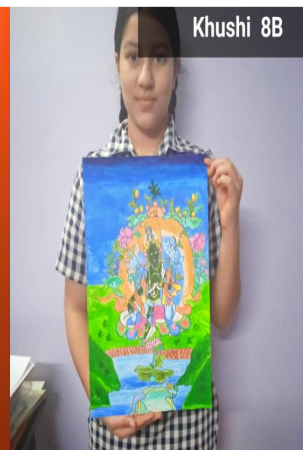

**WHY EDUCATION IS IMPORTANT??**

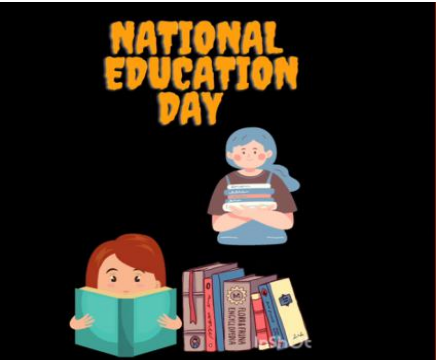
Education is important because:

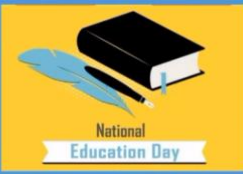



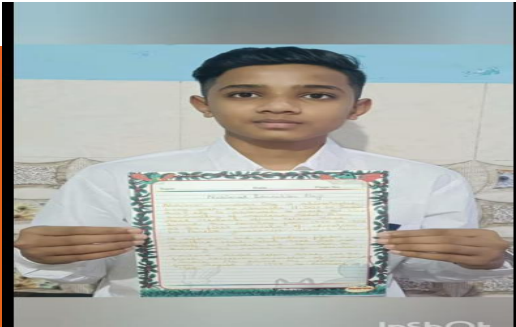

**Class students of 8th celebrated the day of kindness by presenting posters. They also expressed their views towards this day.**



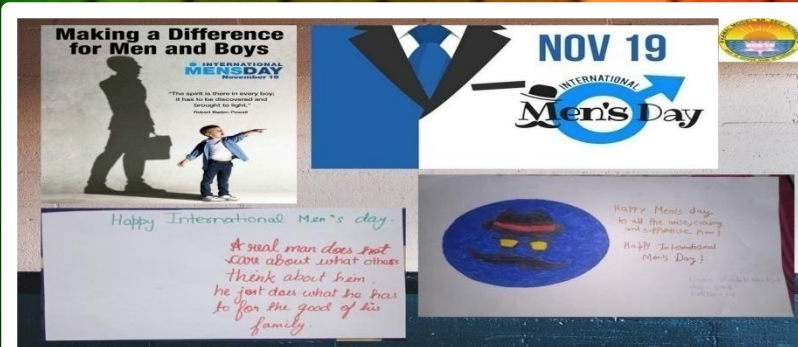
# INTERNATIONAL MENS DAY

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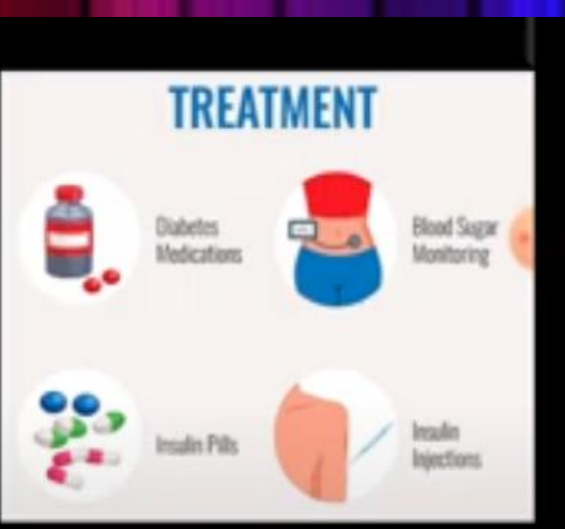
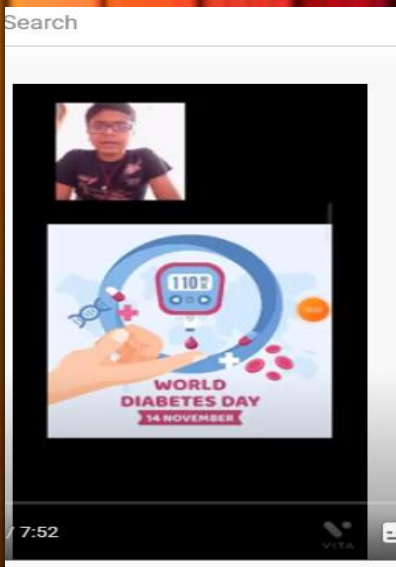
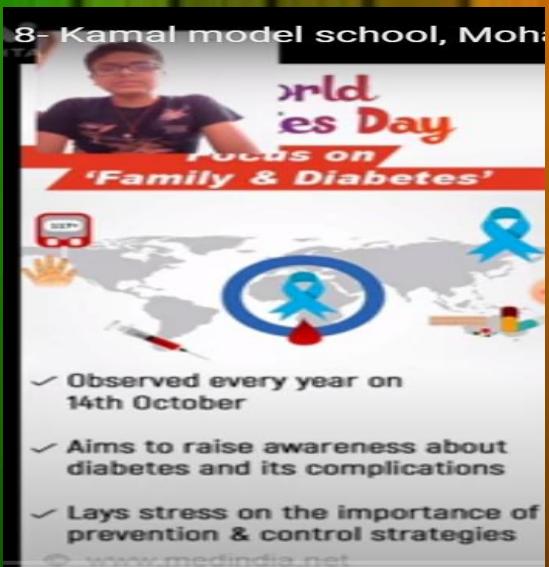


# WORLD DIABETES DAY

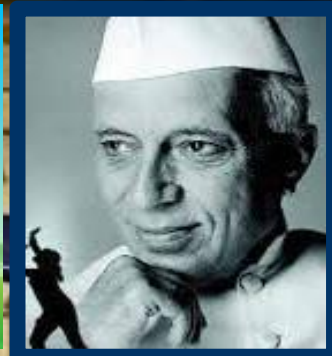

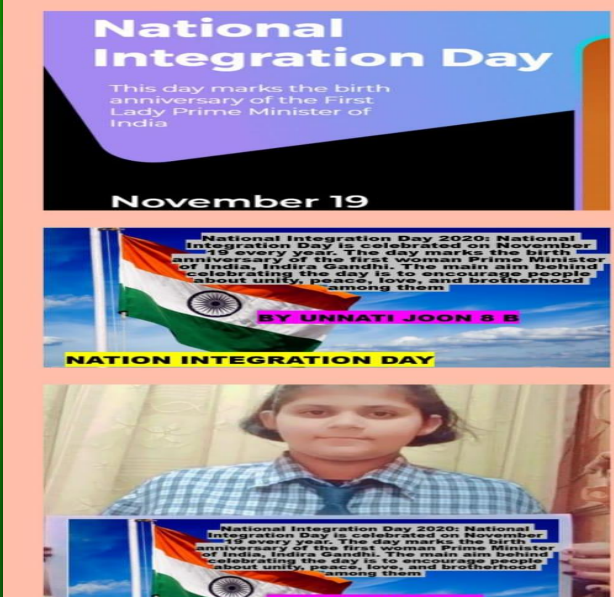


# National Integration Day

Just imagine, you do some illegal work and the people take you against you didn't have proof that you do some illegal but the person you have is saying that you do. So, there's a probability you can win that case. Now, you will think what is probability. So I will tell the definition of probability and some examples.

## What is Probability:-

Probability is nothing but the numerical value of the possibility of occurrence of an event. The value of probability lies between 0 and 1.

### For Example:-

If we toss a coin, then either head will come up or the tail will come up. Thus, there is an even chance of getting a head when a coin is tossed. We say that the probability of getting head or tail is equal and is  $\frac{1}{2}$  for each.

So in above paragraph (imagine one) the probability of winning is 50-50%. Like in example the coin, probability of getting head-tail is 50%-50%.

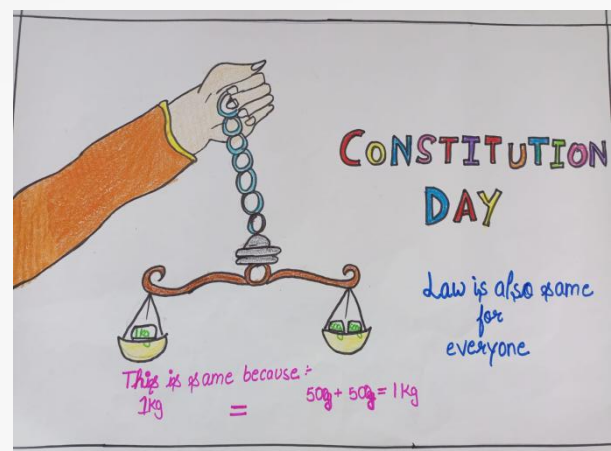

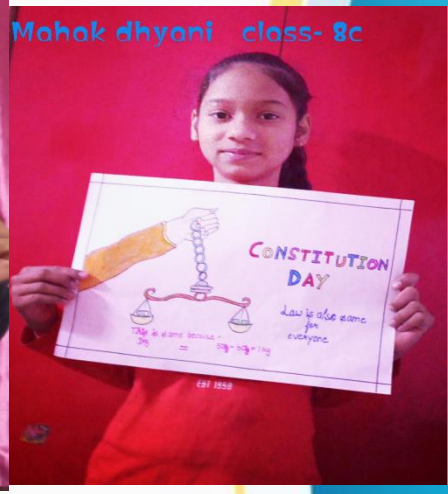

## BEGUM HAZRAT MAHAL



Begum Hazrat Mahal's name was Muhammedi Khanum, and she was born in Faizabad, Awadh, India. Begum Hazrat Mahal, also known as the Begum of Awadh, was the second wife of Nawab of Awadh Wajid Ali Shah, and the regent of Awadh in 1857-1858. She is known for the leading role she had in the rebellion against the British East India Company during the Indian Rebellion of 1857.

After her husband had been exiled to Calcutta and the Indian Rebellion broke out, she made her son, Prince Birjis Qadr, the ruler of Awadh, with herself as regent during his minority. However, she was forced to abandon this role after a short reign. She finally found asylum in Nepal onto Hallaur, she died in 1879 Nepal. Her role in the rebellion has given her a heroine status.

Begum Hazrat Mahal's tomb is located in the central part of Kathmandu near Jama Masjid, Dhantaghar, not far away from the famous Dargah Marg. It is looked after by the Jama Masjid Central Committee.
