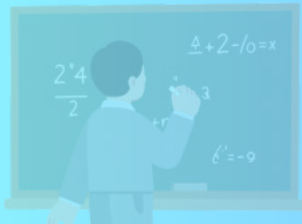
Teacher's Day Celebration

The session concluded with a vote of thanks, reinforcing the importance of strong parent–teacher collaboration for holistic child development.



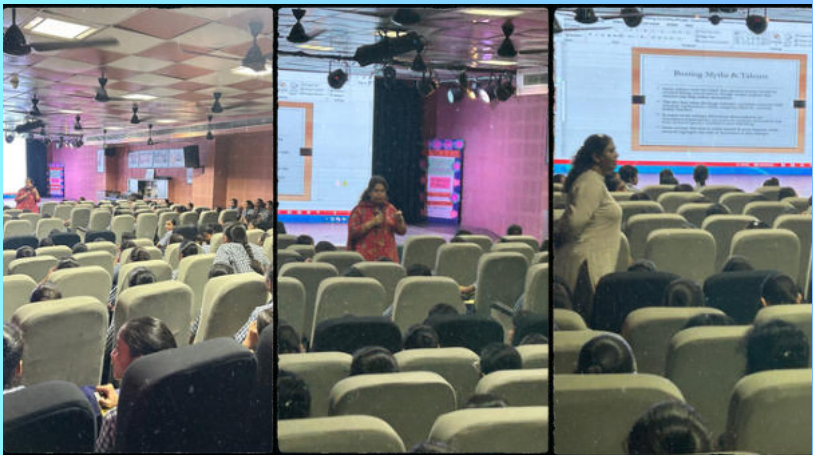
Workshop on Knowledge of Menstrual Cycle

A workshop on POCSO Act and Anti-Bullying was conducted at Kamal Model Senior Secondary School for boys of Classes VI to VIII.

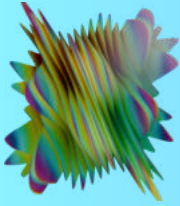
The session aimed to create awareness about child safety, bullying, personal hygiene, and healthy eating habits.

Capacity Building Programme



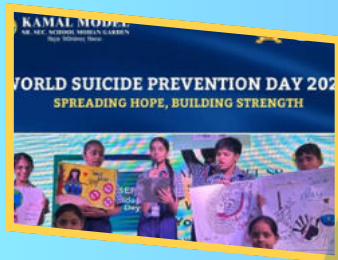
