I wish to begin with our performances on the academic front. Academic achievements reflect ability to perform the best by developing ones intellectual potentials and skills. Excellence in academics is the hall mark of any good institute. Results of class X and XII of the school prove without any doubt that our students have made us proud.

### **Class X**

Class X students stood out commendably and added feathers in the school's cap. Pragya Nidhi – 96.6 % - Dhruv -96% , Ishita – 95.6%, Divya Kumari – 95.4%, Jyoti Kumari – 94.8% were the top position holders amongst the 35 who scored above 90% - 65 students scored above 80%

The highest marks in different subjects scored were 99 in S.St. and Maths, 98 in Hindi, 97 in English and Science.

### **CLASS – XII**

The students of class XII made us feel elated with their outstanding performances. Rahul Pandit with 94.8%, Adarsh Kr. Mishra with 93.8% and Priyanshi Jha with 93.4% from science stream have a claim on noteworthy praise.

Amrita Pritam with 91.6% , was the toppers from the commerce stream.

Humanities stream saw Komal Mirdha with 93.8%, followed by Akash Jha with 90% and Kajal with 86.6%.

A great 100 in Geography by Komal Mirdha stole the show. She deserves a huge cheers.

Other top scorers in various subjects were Priyanshi Jha 97 in english core, Ritik Bisht 97 in maths, Arbaz 96 in physics, Vishram Jha 99 in chemistry, Aadarsh Mishra 99 in biology and

Keshav 95 in Physical Education, Shubham Rawat 90 in Accountancy, Amrita Pritam and Diksha Arora 95 in Business Studies, Amrita Pritam 98 in Economics, Himanshi and Ritu Badotiya 95 in Political science and Kajal and Komal Mirdha 92 in Home Science.

- In Kavyali Competition and Sanskrit shlok our groups took away consolation prize.

**INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIAD-** ORGANIZED BY ICMAS in Vedic Maths and Abacus left us with inspiring results with 4 medals in gold, 3 in silver and 3 in Bronze and 15 in consolation . The countries participated were Nepal, Sri Lanka, Saudi Arabia, Iran and India.

- In Maths olympiad 2018 students came out achieving – 4 Gold, 4- Silver and 2- Bronze medals. Armaan ,Mayank and Nikanshik were selected for second level.
- Coming on to English Olympiad 13<sup>th</sup> Students were selected for II Level. 8 students got Gold , 3 silver and 2 Bronze medal.
- In, Science Olympiad our students showcased outstanding performance with 11 Gold, 9 Silver and 8 Bronze medals.
- Next in Hindi Olympiad our students made us proud with 5 Gold, 3 Silver and 3 Bronze.

Next we come to the area of sports.

It is my pleasure to share with you that our school lifted highest 23 trophies in Zonal Competitions.

- KMS was honoured to hold CBSE Inter School Taekwondo Championship 2018 with participation by 175 schools. KMS lifted the overall championship trophy.
- In Zonal Taekwondo Championship 1 gold, 3 Silver and 5 Bronze medal were attained.
- In North district Taekwondo Championship KMS earned 4 gold, 4 Silver and 5 Bronze medals. Mansi Mishra, Harshita Rawat, Jatin Roy and Priti Kushwaha were selected for Delhi state championship and Harshita was shining star with Bronze at Delhi state championship.
- In Zonal Gymnastics U-14, U-17 and U-19 Girls, U-14, U-17 and U-19 boys showed an outstanding performance and stole away First team trophy.
- In Inter Zonal Gymnastics Girls Jr. Under – 19 once again our girls Shruti Sinha, Navjot Kuar and Khushi stood at I position and their performance was rewarded with cash prize of Rs. 10,000 to each candidate.
- In Inter-Zonal Gymnastics girls pair, under – 19 category, bagged away III position along with cash prize of Rs. 1000 to each candidate.
- In Inter-Zonal Gymnastics mix pair under 19 category once again Vishal Kumar and Khushi showcased an outstanding performance and got I position with cash reward of Rs. 10,000 to each candidate.
- Moving on to Boys in Inter-Zonal Gymnastics Fourier, under 19 category our students Vishal, Anuj, Bhomik and Rajiv achieved III position along with cash reward of Rs. 1000 to each candidate.
- Now comes SGFI under 19 category in acrobatic Navjot Kaur and Shruti Sinha clinched I position all over India and rewarded with 50,000 cash prize.
- In SGFI in Delhi Team Navjot Kaur and Shruti Sinha got the Gold Medal.
- Our school team of 17 students represented the school at CBSE National.

## YOGA

- In Zonal, Yoga witnessed KMS sr. Boys Group at I position followed by Jr. Boys Group at I position and sub Jr. boys group on II position.
- In individual category in Sr. Boys group Hemant Kartick and Vishal bagged top positions.
- In individual category in Jr. Boys group Armaan (I position), Sharad II position and Harsh bagged IV position.
- In Delhi state Yoga completion in Individual Category Armaan, Sachin, Kapil, Pratham, Ayush, Hemant, Mayank were victorious and were selected for National Yoga championship.

## Athletics

- Aastha Sanchi, Prisha Kant, Ankita Nagar and Sakshi came out as winners at Ist, IInd, IVTH and VI position respectively in Zonal cross country race girls group.
- Vishaldeep and Ajay Negi won IV and V position in the Zonal Cross Country race in boys Sr. Group.
- In Zonal athletic championship Sr. Girls saw IInd position coming up to them.
- Zonal athletic championship Jr. Girls also saw IInd position awaiting for them.
- In Zonal Athletics KMS received 7 gold, 4 silver and 6 Bronze medals.
- In CBSE athletics cluster Championship 3000 mtr. Prishakant stood at II position. Prishakant also represented school at CBSE National held at Davanagere, Karnataka and attained VII position.
- Prisha Kant in Sr. group and Aastha Sanchi in Jr. Group were titled as best athletes.

## **JUDO**

- In zonal Judo Championships KMS conquered II<sup>nd</sup> position in all 3 categories , Sr. Girls group, Jr. Girls group and Sub Jr. Girls group.
- In Jr. boys group KMS again rose at II<sup>nd</sup> position.
- The total of 1 gold, 2 silver and 10 bronze medals were bagged
- Jinal Biswas was the shining star who represented the school at CBSE Judo National Championship.
  
- In Zonal Kabaddi competition 2018-19 under 17 Boys group achieved the well deserved II<sup>nd</sup> position.
- In Zonal Volley Ball Competition 2018-19 under 17 boys the school bagged III<sup>rd</sup> position.
