World Soil Day

World Soil Day (WSD) is held annually on 5 December as a means to focus attention on the importance of healthy soil and advocating for the sustainable management of soil resources. An international day to celebrate Soil was recommended by the International Union of Soil Sciences (IUSS) in 2002. Under the leadership of the Kingdom of Thailand and within the framework of the Global Soil Partnership, FAO has supported the formal establishment of WSD as a global awareness raising platform. The FAO Conference unanimously endorsed World Soil Day in June 2013 and requested its official adoption at the 68th UN General Assembly. In December 2013 the UN General Assembly responded by designating 5 December 2014 as the first official World Soil Day.

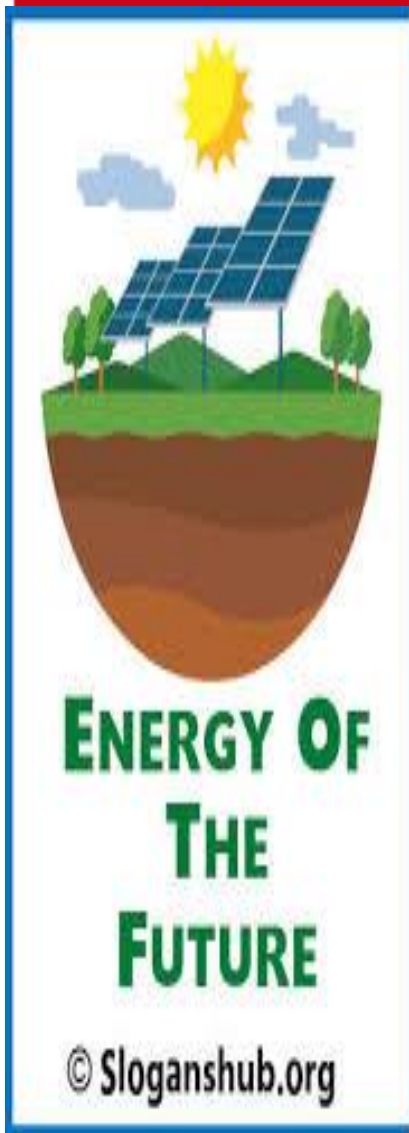


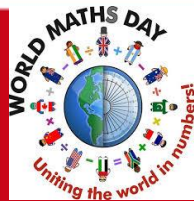


National Energy Conservation Day

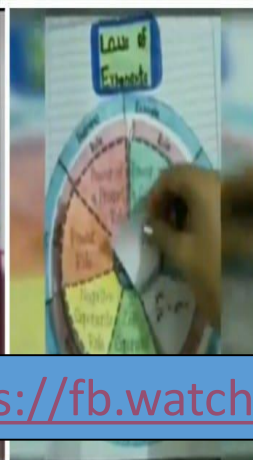
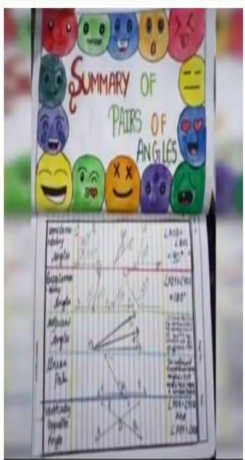
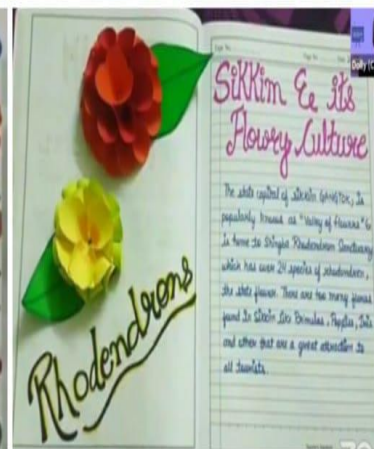
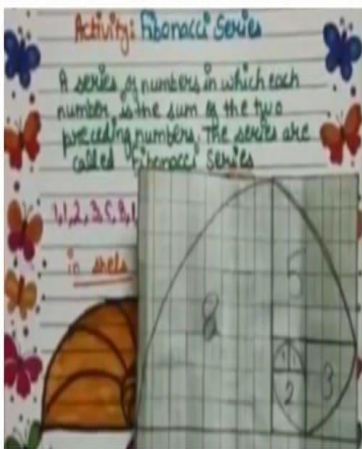
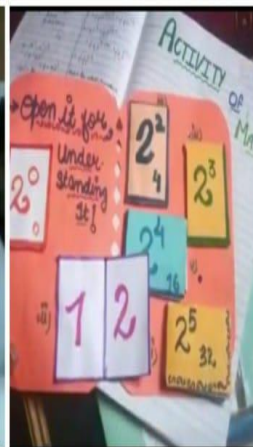


National Mathematics Day

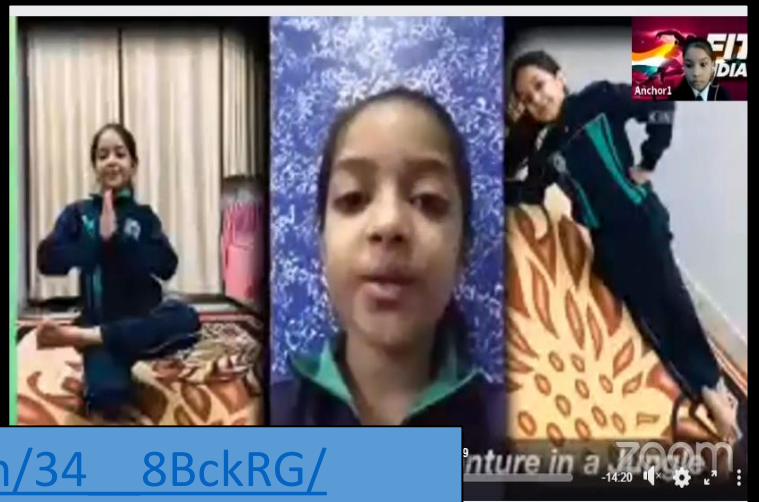
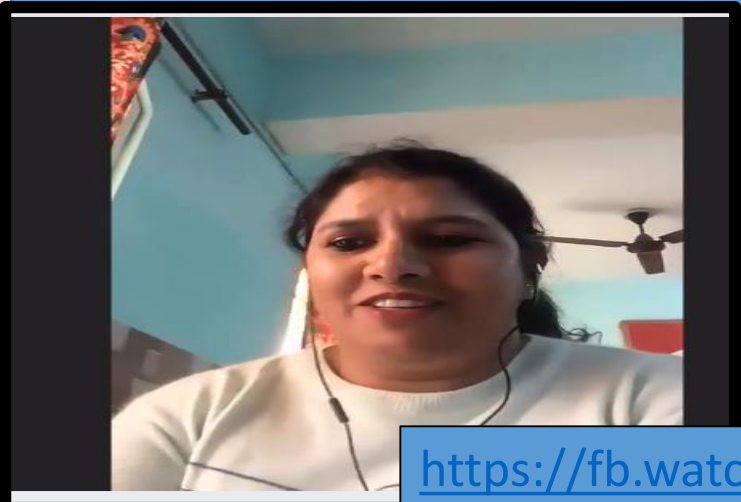
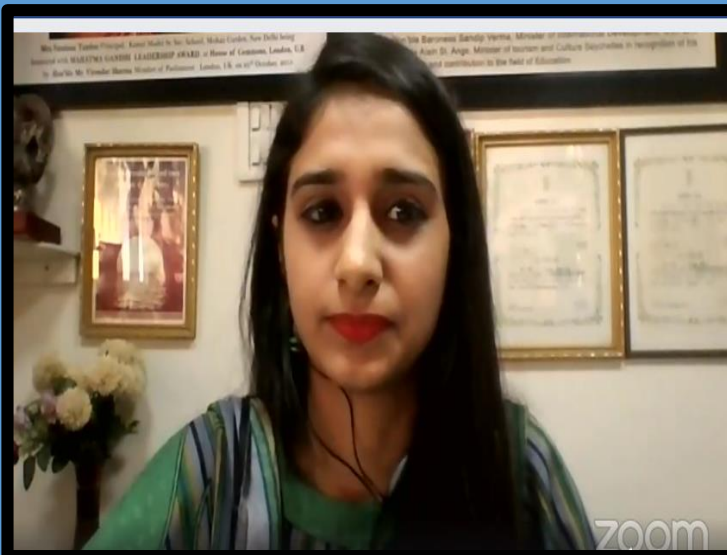


Webinar on Fitness 2020

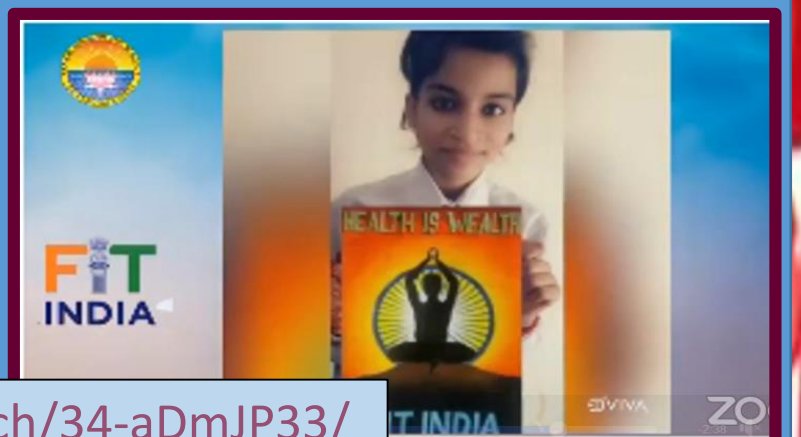

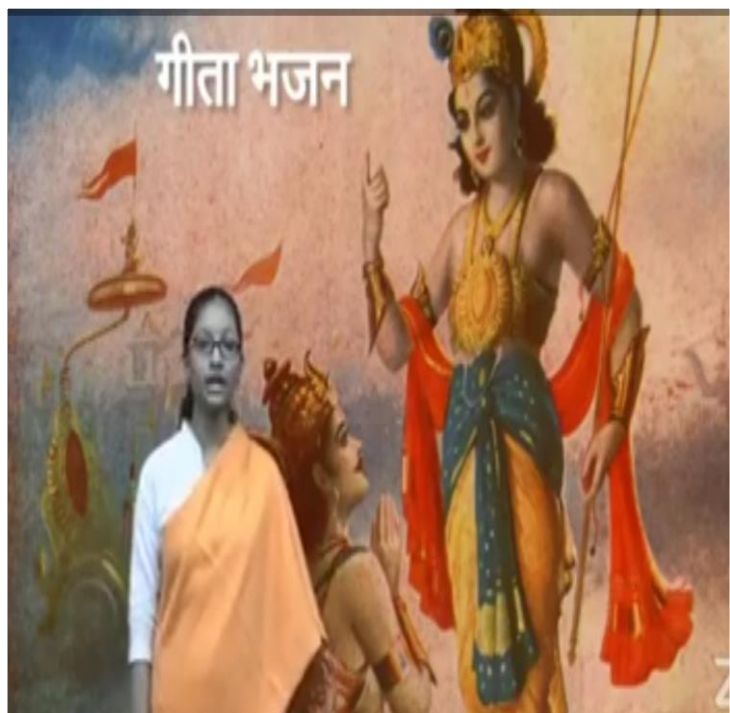

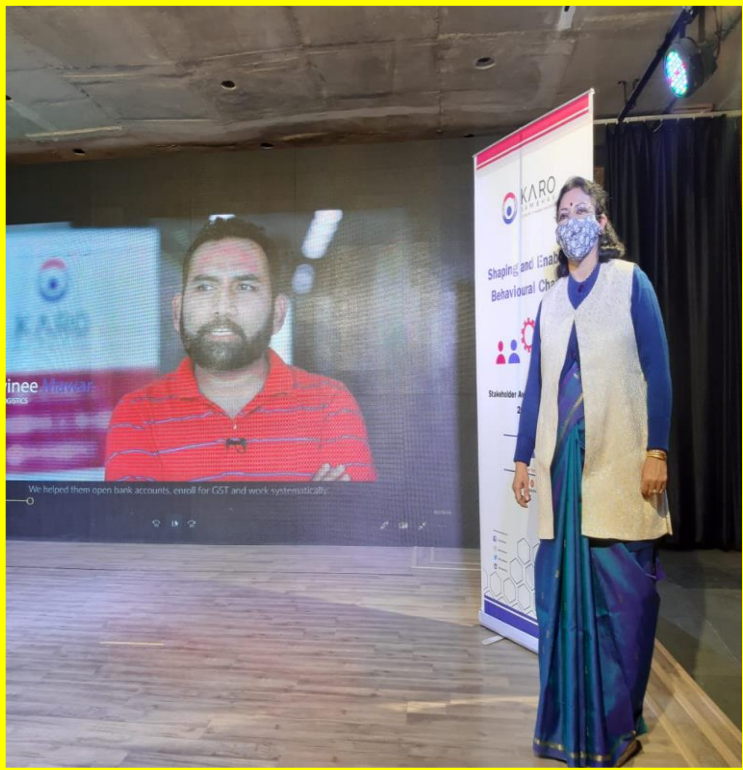


Workshop on E-Waste Management

She enlightened the listeners by saying that we as consumers should hand the old devices into the shop where the new is purchased or some company that specialises in electronic refurbishment. This could reduce the release of poisons into the atmosphere ,water, soil to minimise the negative impact on health and environment. Being associated with **KARO SAMBHAV ORGANISATION**, she also enlightened about the various nearby centres where we could give away such items that generate e- waste and thus save the health of a number of citizens.

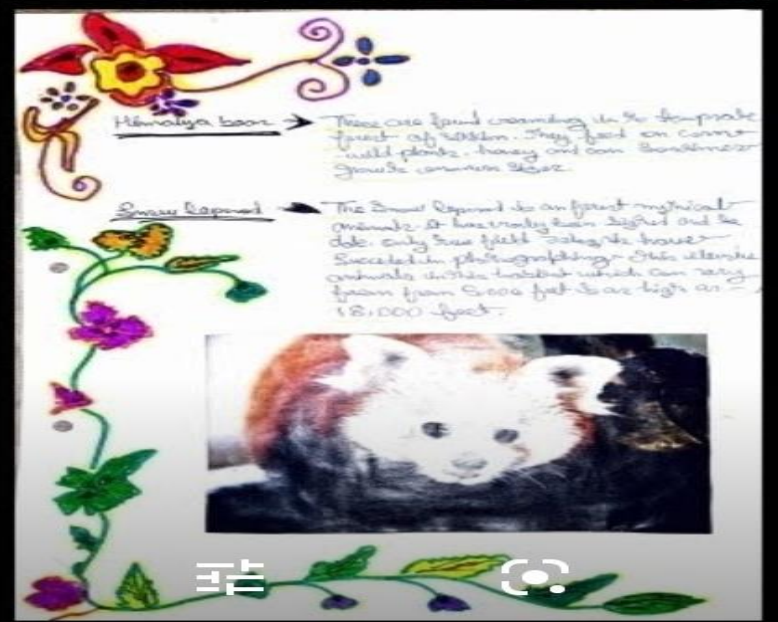
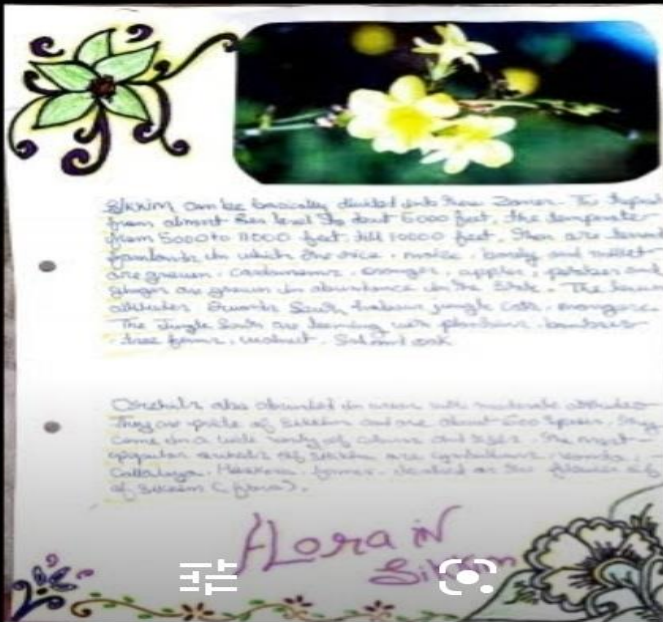
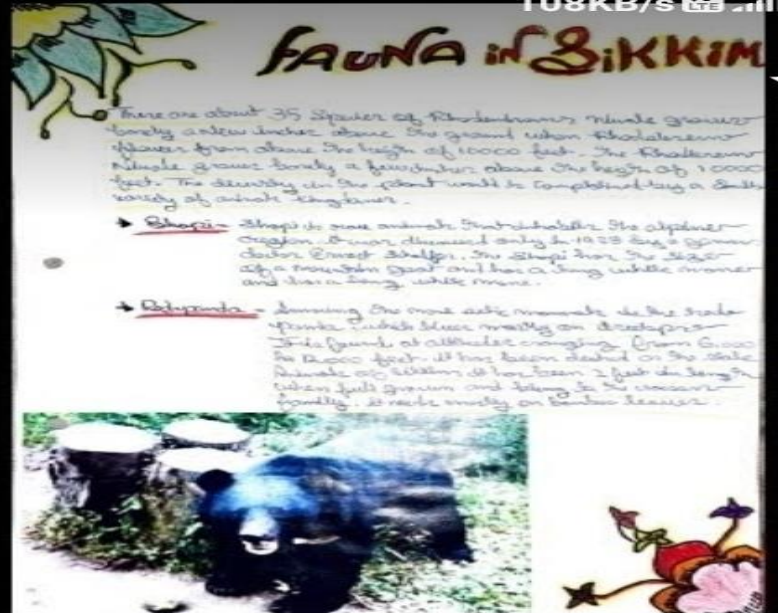
Students represented their different ways of cropping pattern, Irrigation process, different seasonal crop pattern in different seasons.

GREEN SIKKIM

Sikkim was named the cleanest state in the 'Swacch Survekshan Ghuman 2016' report with all four of its districts ranking among top ten districts in cleanliness and sanitization. 98.2% households in Sikkim are equipped with clean toilets. All 6,10,577 people have high sanitary and hygienic latrines.

Sikkim began its cleanliness drive over a decade before prime minister Narendra Modi launched the Swacch Bharat mission. It was 13 years ago 2003 when the paison chomling-led government launched its state sanitation campaign for the state.

SIKKIM a window of Himalaya



In Sikkim main cities such as Gangtok or Namchi (the latest addition to the central government's list of smart cities), there has been a conscious effort to install public filters for drinking water, build more public toilets and introduce a better sewage system. Some of the parameters often deployed to rank a city's cleanliness.

However, Bhangtok mayor Shakti Singh Choudhary, a Haryanai born and brought up in Sikkim, is not happy with the city receiving only the eighth rank in all India smart city ranking survey - Swacch Survekshan 2016 - released early this year.
